- 8 Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.
- 9 (Now that he ascended, what is it but that he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth?
- 10 He that descended is the same also <u>that</u> ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.)

He Ascended Up on High

Our Lord Jesus Christ first descended to the lowest parts of the earth, and then He ascended up far above all heavens, where He is at this very hour.

Ephesians 4:8-10

What does <u>ascend</u> mean?

To go up!

In this case ... for Jesus to go up from earth to heaven!

He Ascended Up on High

Our Lord Jesus Christ first came down to a humble and lowly life on earth, and then He went up far above all heavens, where He is at this very hour.

Ephesians 4:8-10

The <u>birth</u> of Jesus is important. Two gospels record its details.

The <u>death</u> of Jesus is important. Four gospels record its details.

His <u>resurrection</u> is important. Four gospels record its details.

His <u>ascension</u> is also important. Three gospels mention it.

But His <u>ascension</u> is mentioned many other times in the Bible.

Why Is His Ascension Neglected?

- Futurism has Him on hold for at least 1,007 years!
- A "tribulation" and "millennium" must occur first.
- There is no RC holy day like Christmas and Easter.
- Rome has Ascension Thursday ... but who keeps it?
- A proud and lying spirit does not want it known!

Great Mystery of Godliness

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

I Timothy 3:16

Behold, my servant shall deal prudently, he shall be exalted and extolled, and be very high.

Isaiah 52:13

What and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where he was before?

John 6:62

Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for <u>I am not yet</u> ascended to my Father:

John 20:17

Jesus saith unto her ... say unto them, <u>I ascend unto my</u> <u>Father</u>, and your Father; and to my God, and your God:

John 20:17

Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?

Luke 24:26

So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God.

Mark 16:19

And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven.

Luke 24:51

The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus ... until the day in which he was taken up.

Acts 1:1-2

Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted ... he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

Acts 2:33

David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,

Acts 2:34

Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things.

Acts 3:21

But he ... looked up ... into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,

Acts 7:55

And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.

Acts 7:56

Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God.

Romans 8:34

Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

Philippians 2:9

Who being the brightness of his glory ... when he had by himself purged our sins, <u>sat</u> down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Hebrews 1:3

Being made so much better than the angels, as he hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.

Hebrews 1:4

But we see Jesus ... <u>crowned</u> with glory and honour;

Hebrews 2:9

Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

Hebrews 6:20

This is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;

Hebrews 8:1

But by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

Hebrews 9:12

For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:

Hebrews 9:24

But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;

Hebrews 10:12

Looking unto Jesus ... who for the joy that was set before him ... is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Hebrews 12:2

Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

I Peter 3:22

And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne.

Revelation 12:5

In the midst of the throne ... stood a Lamb as it had been slain ... he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.

Revelation 5:6-7

And he that overcometh ... will I give power over the nations: And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; even as I received of my Father.

Revelation 2:26-27

To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

Revelation 3:21
