

The Three B's of Salvation

Belief ... faith in Jesus Christ as Son of God and Saviour.

Baptism ... use of water in various denominational ways.

Birth ... being born again or regenerated as a child of God.

Roman Catholicism and Her Infant-Baptizing Daughters

Alexander Campbell, a renegade Presbyterian and renegade Baptist, rejected infant baptism, so he started his own church with believers' baptismal regeneration. Acts 2:38 is pretty much their total hope.

Fundamentalists, Charismatics, and Mega Churches

Arminian followers of Charles Finney, D.L Moody, Billy Graham, Benny Hinn, and Joel Osteen teach that accepting Jesus Christ gets you born again, and then you can be baptized for a public profession.

Belief ... Birth ... Baptism

The Bible teaches regeneration comes first to save the elect from their depraved natures in order to believe and obey, and baptism by immersion then follows mature faith as faith's activity and evidence.
