Ephesians 6:10-17

Introduction

- After five chapters...
- After writing about our roles as Christians.
- Paul has come to a conclusion.
- Paul has a powerful final exhortation.
- Resisting the temptations of the devil.



Verse 10a Finally, my brethren,

Like a salutation in a letter... Chosen brethren from chapter one. A final exhortation about our spiritual walk.

Introduction (3)

Verse 10b

- be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might.
- We can do these things by the power of HIS might!!!
- For Thine is the power!!!
- We have been given the tools to win.
- Christ has already defeated the Devil.
- Christ has already overcome the World.
- We can do all things through Christ.
- We are more than conquerors.
- We must approach with HIS might.

Introduction (4)

Verse 12

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

- We are at war!
- Before we can go any further we must understand the importance of the passage.
 - I Peter 5:8
 - A call to arms!
 - Is there not a cause!



Six words to explain the situation. Let's get the sense

Six components to overcome it. Let's understand the metaphor

Verse 10

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

Action, Command, Do something, etc.We are not called to look or talk strong.

Word #1 (2)

Deut. 31:6

Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

Verse 11

Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

- You cannot do it yourself; you are not strong enough.
- We are to do something.
- We must put on the tools necessary to be successful.

Verse 11

Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

- Mentioned three times; withstand once.
- We better not be found asleep.
- We better not take a rest.
- We better not give up.

Verse 12

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

- We must understand the effort necessary.
- Continuous, extreme exertion.

Verse 11

Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil

- The Devil is crafty.
- He is smarter than you.
- He is <u>allowed</u> to lie.
- He will use your heart.
- He will <u>listen</u> to you.

Verse 13

Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

- The armour works together.
- It is a whole suit of armour.
- We cannot leave cracks.

It is not being a hypocrite.

Piece #2 (3) What is Righteousness?

Deut 6:25

And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the LORD our God, as he hath commanded us.

Ps 15:2

He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart.

Piece #2 (4) What is Righteousness?

Ps 18:20 The LORD rewarded me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands hath he recompensed me.

Ps 18:24 Therefore hath the LORD recompensed me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands in his eyesight.

Piece #2 (5) What is righteousness?

 Isa 59:17 For He put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon His head; and He put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloak.

The Word of God




Piece #6 (3) What is the Word of God?
