Let Jesus start our comparison of men.

#### Matthew 21:28-32

But what think ye?

#### A certain man had two sons;

and he came to the first, and said, Son, go work to day in my vineyard.

He answered and said, I will not: but afterward he repented, and went.

And he came to the second, and said likewise. And he answered and said, I go, sir: and went not.

# Whether of them twain did the will of his father?

They say unto him, The first.

#### Jesus saith unto them,

Verily I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots go into the kingdom of God before you.

For John came unto you in the way of righteousness, and ye believed him not:

but the publicans and the harlots believed him:

and ye, when ye had seen it, repented not afterward, that ye might believe him.

#### Two Sons ... Asked to Work

Son #1

Son #2

"I will not work."

• "I will work, sir."

He then repented.

• But he did not work.

He went and worked.

He stayed rebellious.

#### Two Groups ... Hearing the Gospel

#### Publicans & Harlots

**Priests & Elders** 

They were sinners.

They were self-righteous.

But they repented.

They did not repent.

- They changed their lives.
- They would not change.

#### Repentant Sinners

Self-righteous Fakes

- They know they are bad.
- They think they are fine.

- They repent at truth.
- They ignore warnings.

- They change their lives.
  - They never change.

#### Two Kinds ... of Christians

#### Repentant Sinners

Self-righteous Fakes

They love warnings.

They are polite talkers.

They make mistakes.

• They have little fruit.

They grow in grace.

They stay in their rut.

Jesus compared men another way.



And that servant, which knew his lord's will, and prepared not himself, neither did according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes.

But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes.

For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.

#### Two Kinds ... of Servants

#### **Knowing & Disobedient**

**Ignorant & Disobedient** 

- Knew the master's will.
- Did not know his will.

- Disobeyed his master.
- Broke the master's rules.

- Beaten many stripes!
- Still beaten few stripes!

#### Two Kinds ... of Christians

#### **Taught**

**Ignorant** 

- Pastor preaches truth.
- No pastor or weak one.

- No excuse of ignorance.
- Little knowledge of God.

Judged severely!

Judged mercifully!

He also compared men with eternal consequences.

When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him ... he shall separate them one from another ... and he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. **Matthew 25:31-33** 

Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

Matthew 25:34

Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

Matthew 25:41

Would you agree this is a pretty big difference?

Cursed! Everlasting fire!

All men shall give an account of their lives.

For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil.

**Ecclesiastes 12:14** 

In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.

Romans 2:16

For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ....

So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.

Romans 14:10-12

For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.

Il Corinthians 5:10

All will be exposed and judged strictly.

- Ignored or endured.

 Took Salem; led army.


Sweet Psalmist of Israel.

**Proverbs 9:13-15** 


Stolen waters are sweet, and bread eaten in secret is pleasant.
