Every Christian Should Be Great

- Life is too short to waste it being average.
- It is certainly not hard to be above average.
- The rewards are excellent for being above average.
- The motives and rewards are highest for the Christian.
- Why would any Christian settle for merely an average life?

Consider Paul

- I labored more abundantly than they all (I Cor 15:10).
- I was not a whit behind the chiefest apostles (II Cor 11:5).
- In nothing am I behind the chiefest apostles (II Cor 12:11).
- Are they ministers of Christ? I am more (II Cor 11:23).
- I fought a good fight, finished my course, kept the faith.

What Is Greatness?

- The world's ideas are only ... vanity and vexation of spirit!
- Worldlings are generally frustrated and then go to hell!
- We measure greatness by God's description in scripture.
- To max God's favor ... man's favor ... return on pound, etc.
- For a full explanation, see the study ... <u>Make Your Life Count</u>.

Greatness Requires a Great Cause

- Great men live by a cause greater than themselves.
- This is even true of reprobates, for they have great men.
- Immaturity and selfishness reduces greatness for all men.
- Demented psychologists may confound it as *altruism.*
- Great men live by a cause greater than themselves.

Greatness Is Lost Without a Cause

- Great men live by a cause greater than themselves.
- Greatness involves sacrificial choices requiring a cause.
- With no great cause outside themselves, men are selfish.
- Selfishness leads to foolish choices costing greatness.
- Great men live by a cause greater than themselves.

Even Reprobates Have Great Causes

- The great ones among them are driven by a great cause.
- William Wallace (Braveheart) had a cause ... "Freedom!"
- Robin Hood had what cause? ... Transfer wealth to poor!
- Alexander the Great had a cause ... Revenge on Persia!
- Adolph Hitler had what cause? ... Aryan dream of 1000yrs!

Reprobates Often Shame Us - 1

- They will sacrifice most anything for their cause. Will you?
- Japanese *kamikaze* pilots died in a losing cause for sake!
- Muslim *jihad* terrorists kill themselves for a moon god!
- Priests and nuns swear *celibacy* and *poverty* for a fairy!
- What do you sacrifice to prove you serve Christ's kingdom?







Reprobates Often Shame Us - 2

- Mormon young men (18-20) give two years to missions.
- They live two years doing daily evangelism in distant cities.
- They do this at their own expense for travel and all costs.
- They tell a Mormon fable about Joe and Jews and Indians.
- They may be ridiculed and despised by many, but they do it.










Reprobates Often Shame Us - 3


- Secret Service men will take a bullet for the president.

- Their god is native freewill our God is sovereign Saviour.

































George Washington

- The "father of the nation," first president, and great man.
- He was a courier, scout, soldier, general, president, etc.
- The squabbling nation had total trust in him for anything.
- His character was impeccable with faithfulness and zeal.
- What was his cause? A sacrificial concern for this nation.

Most Do Not Have a Cause

- All children are born with one only ambition themselves.
- At 10, they still only think of themselves, except for rules.
- At 20, it is nearly too late to get a cause, if they have none.
- They are self-centered, pleasure-mad, short-termers, etc.
- Parents grieve at immaturity ... for all fools lack a cause.

No Cause Leaves Men Boys

- There are many 40-year-old boys still playing boy games.
- They never got a vision of anything greater than their fun.
- They might work hard ... but they do it mainly for money.
- They might serve well ... but they do it mainly for praise.
- Without a cause, a man will grow up prioritizing by self.

Do Not Confuse Goals with a Cause


- The goal to be cool ... is only a selfish, idiotic, un-cause.
- The goal to be cool ... rich ... successful ... is not a cause.
- A cause as we define it here must be <u>fully outside yourself.</u>
- A goal no matter how good ... around you ... is not a cause.
- A cause here is a thing ... much larger ... and outside you.

A Cause Will Change a Man

- Many boys never grow up, for they do not have a cause.
- As soon as a boy gets a cause, he can become a real man.
- His choices switch from self to the cause, no matter what.
- Immaturity is a man holding on to childish things of self.
- Greater the cause or commitment, greater the man. Glory!

What a Cause Can Do!

- Consider the martyrs how could they cheerfully burn?
- Athletes possibly for country deny and train extremely.
- For a kingdom, a prince's life is totally altered from others.
- To win a battle or silence a gun crew, some quickly die.
- To save lives, consider doctors, police, firefighters, etc.




Paul Always Had a Great Cause


- He loved the LORD Jehovah and His religion from his youth.
- He thought he should persecute Christians for God's sake.
- His great cause, with a conscience, made him a great Jew.
- But Jesus Christ revealed to Him God's cause in full truth.
- He became the greatest apostle by his new great cause.

Paul Was Exceptional


- The cause of Christ was greater to him than anything.
- Therefore, he could keep his body under and deny himself.
- Therefore, he was usually disappointed with other men.
- Therefore, he did not have a wife, home, hobby, or iPhone.
- Therefore, he was willing to live or die for Christ his Lord.
































David Was Great with God and Men

- He was the man after God's own heart ... he replaced Saul.
- God liked him (I Chr 28:4) ... and delighted in him (Ps 18:19).
- Jesus is called the Son of David and even David (Jer 30:9).
- He gat himself a name ... and his name was much set by.
- His zeal for God's house and worship was exceptional.

Why Was David Greater than Others?

- Great men live by a cause greater than themselves.
- He loved Jehovah and delighted in Him unlike other men.
- David loved God's word and delighted in it unlike others.
- David loved God's house and worship unlike other men.
- David loved the kingdom of God and its future glory much.

David Heard Goliath

- Great men live by a cause greater than themselves.
- He could not grasp the army would let Goliath blaspheme.
- Especially with the rewards offered by fearful King Saul.
- His brother Eliab, shamed by his questions, ridiculed him.
- David's response was perfect, *"Is there not a cause?"*

Is There Not a Cause?

- Great men live by a cause greater than themselves.
- David was not interested in fame, rank, prestige, pay, etc.
- He loved Israel's God, Jehovah, and he hated His enemies.
- This life-risking passion for Jehovah drove David and Paul.
- He could face Goliath ... or dance in the street like a fool.

God's Cause Was Preeminent

- Great men live by a cause greater than themselves.
- He humbly answered Saul's query as merely Jesse's son.
- He did not think himself worthy to marry Saul's daughter.
- He did not mind paying for a temple named after his son.
- He did not mind dying a family failure with God's promise.

You Face a New Goliath - 1

- We live in the perilous times of the last days ... perilous!
- Christians have compromised holy living until all is liberty.
- The cause driving most Christians is *lovers of pleasures.*
- Their cause will not allow them to endure *sound doctrine*.
- To serve God you must be <u>different</u> and will be <u>persecuted</u>.

You Face a New Goliath - 2

- Will you despise all jesting and foolish talk to be sober?
- Will you continue in a church with two, two-hour services?
- Will you hate worldly music and faithless entertainment?
- Will you get involved and serve the kingdom every week?
- Will you reject worldly friends for only those that love God?

What Makes You Like Eliab?

- Most men are like Eliab ... lacking drive by a great cause.
- You think selling out for Jesus and holy living is extreme.
- You cannot think outside the bonds of your lusts and pride.
- The "cause" to you is a mental assent mainly on Sundays.
- Work, wife, workout, school, fun, toys, and such drive you.

David Was a Stud – Eliab a Dud!

- He was the oldest and best of Jesse's sons. So what!
- He worked harder than the rest in the army. So what!
- He took good care of Daddy by writing monthly. So what!
- He took breaks to relax himself and have fun. So what!
- When a challenge came, he had no reason to risk himself.

Other Bible Examples - 1

- Why did Phinehas react with zeal against fornicators?
- Why did Jonathan not fear taking on a Philistine garrison?
- How did three Hebrew men defy the livid Nebuchadnezzar?
- Why did Esther and Mordecai risk her life so boldly?
- Why did Jesus use a scourge ... and allow an unjust death?

Other Bible Examples - 2

- Anna spend her life fasting and praying in the temple.
- Peter denied Jesus and His cause ... but wept bitterly.
- Fifty days later he boldly declared Him and His cause.
- What caused Joseph to deny Mrs. Potiphar's advances?
- Why did Moses blow off the riches and pleasures of Egypt?

The Greatest Cause

- Makes the greatest men of all time ... in the Hall of Faith.
- It is good to be zealously affected always in a good cause.
- The cause of Christ our King demolishes all other causes.
- Paul saw the cause clearly and helped teach it to Timothy.
- A "man in Christ" wrote an English paper of the Great Awakening's effect on the American Revolution ... a cause of God's sovereignty!

Our Cause Is the Greatest

- The true God Jehovah and His glorious Son Jesus Christ!
- The truth of the universe on all topics natural or spiritual!
- Redemption, justification, adoption from doom to sons!
- Immortality and eternal heaven with God forever and ever!
- Final and ultimate victory over all enemies of all kinds!

Think of Recent Preaching

- The kingdom of God is to be <u>first</u> in your life (Matt 6:33).
- You have a charge ... <u>Occupy till I come (Luke 19:11-27)</u>.
- <u>Character</u> is the rules of conduct you live by for your king.
- <u>Paul</u> gives you an example second to none of a cause.
- <u>Patriarchy</u> calls for Christian men to man up for godliness.

It Totally Consumed Paul

- Since we must give an account, the <u>terror persuaded</u> him.
- Since Jesus Christ died for him, the <u>love constrained</u> him.
- He counted all things, even his religious things, <u>as dung</u>!
- He did not care whether he honored Christ by life or death.
- His resume lists accomplishments shaming us all as Eliabs!

It Should Consume You

- Which do you prefer, past or future (Rom 12:1-2; I Jn 3:1-3)?
- Jesus is precious or a stone of stumbling. Which to you?
- Are you willing to do anything, or give up anything, easily?
- You will be different from others and subject to ridicule.
- Jehovah seeks a man, not a crowd, to stand (Ezek 22:30).

There Are Great Risks - 1

- God's cause has great power, wisdom, and reward for you!
- Your cause has delusional power, wisdom, and reward!
- God's cause has supernatural (and natural) advantages.
- Your cause has supernatural (and natural) disadvantages.
- World mocks living for God; God mocks living for the world!

There Are Great Risks - 2

- Being foolish in youth seems okay ... regret is coming fast!
- Your good friends hate belly-worshippers; you'll lose them.
- Only losers love belly-worshippers; they are all you'll have.
- If you save your life, you lose it; if you lose it, you'll find it.
- A terrible day is coming you will answer for every choice.

A Life Example - Your Job

- How will you work at your job tomorrow, and why?
- Losers work to be seen and please men for advancement.
- Christians may work a little harder, for the same reason.
- Our cause teaches obedience and diligence much higher!
- It is to the Lord, who also rewards far better (Col 3:22-25).

A Life Example - Your Marriage

- You marry only the spiritually best with great fear of God.
- You lead the marriage by faith for both to grow in Christ.
- You and your wife serve Christ and His people all the time.
- You only have children for kingdom purposes, or you don't.
- Together you train children to have the same great cause.

A Life Example - Your Friends

- You reject any and all friends not fearing God (Ps 101:2-11).
- You choose only friends with passionate love for Christ.
- You choose only friends craving God's word and keeping it.
- When you gather with them, the focus is always spiritual.
- The emphasis, even with friends, is to serve them, not you.

A Life Example - Your Church

- The church, the body, is Christ's the temple of Jehovah.
- You pray, prepare, and participate fully in all assemblies.
- You emphasize every "one another" duty to whole family.
- You zealously serve it in every way you can find or create.
- You make the worship and church life the best it can be.

Life Examples - Everything

- How do you drive? Every driving choice is for the cause.
- What is your entertainment? Is it all chosen to honor God?
- Marital sex is to please the King through His daughter.
- You play less and work and serve for most waking hours.
- You devise liberal things for God's glory and those in need.
- Though rulers may be basest of men, you honor for God.
- You are conservative in Christian liberty and offend none.
- Praise, singing, and worship for you is beyond just church.
- No enemy, regardless, moves you to compromise truth.
- You are a tree of life to all and win souls where possible.

- Examine yourself as to whether you are a reprobate or not.
- Agree the cause needs a total lifestyle not just Sundays.
- Are you living the "mighty man's life" in whole or in part?
- Give up <u>anything</u> not maxing God's cause no matter what.
- Be as temperate as an Olympic athlete denying yourself.

- Show and teach your children to be kingdom servants.
- Or they will grow up to be self-centered, carnal Christians.
- Great delight in singing, contrary to most worship, is part.
- Forgiving others, no matter how offended, is for the Lord.
- Hospitality is no longer a burden or cost but a privilege!

- Working to have money for the Lord is the goal (Eph 4:28).
- Every Christian duty takes on a new life and purpose!
- Training children is not for you or them ... but the kingdom.
- Youth group is not for you it is for the King and others!
- Loving brethren and serving them is promoting a kingdom.

- The five inputs are actually for the King against Satan!
- Is your life motivated, structured, and executed for Christ?
- Go out of here tonight to make every choice for the cause.
- Live life minute by minute in light of our glorious cause.
- If you opt out ... you are an immature boy belly-worshipper!

Our Cause Is the Only Cause

- All but Jehovah and His Son Jesus Christ is lying vanity!
- Every holy book but the King James Bible is twaddle!
- All the best of earth is only vanity and vexation of spirit!
- Christ died for us (love); He is coming to judge (terror).
- Eternal inheritance with Christ crushes any cause or goal.
