Psalm 50:23

Psalm 69:30-31

30 I will <u>praise</u> the name of God with a song, and will <u>magnify</u> him with <u>thanksgiving</u>.

31 This also shall please the LORD better than an ox or bullock that hath horns and hoofs.

Psalm 35:18

I will give thee thanks in the great congregation: I will praise thee among much people.

Psalm 107:21-22

- 21 Oh that men would <u>praise</u> the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- 22 And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing.

Psalm 34:1-3

- 1 I will <u>bless</u> the LORD at all times: his <u>praise</u> shall continually be in my mouth.
- 2 My soul shall make her <u>boast</u> in the LORD: the humble shall hear thereof, and <u>be glad</u>.
