Our God Is Holy

- He cannot approve of sinners (Ex 34:7; Na 1:3; Hab 1:13).
- He hates sin and sinners (Pr 6:16-19; Ps 5:5; 11:5; 139:21-22).
- He judges the wicked severely (Ps 7:11; Rev 21:8,27).
- He chastens saints severely (Acts 5:1-11; | Cor 11:30).
- Saints are polluted in His sight (Job 42:5-6; Isaiah 6:1-7).

He Expects You to Be Holy

- So He condemns unholy religion (Is 1:10-15; II Tim 3:2).
- So He commands your holiness (I Pet 1:13-17; Heb 12:14).
- We must cut off unholy activities (I Co 6:19-20; II Co 7:1).
- We must cut off unholy friends (I Cor 15:33; Titus 1:8).
- We must exclude unholy members (I Cor 5:9-11).

But Jesus died to save sinners!

This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.



You Are Legally Forgiven (1)

- Jesus paid for elect's sins past, present, future.
- God forgave elect legally through Jesus (Eph 1:3-8).
- There is total peace with God for Judgment Day.
- There is no variation at anytime in this standing.
- The key here is faith and works to prove election.

You Are Legally Forgiven (2)

- This is a once-for-all forgiveness to legal holiness.
- Nothing can ever be laid to your charge legally.
- There is no starting over legally *it is finished*!
- Yet ... as foolish rebels ... we continue to sin.
- These sins bring grief, guilt, and God's chastening.

What Happens When You Sin?

- You grieve and offend God and bring chastening.
- It should not happen, but it does happen, often.
- You lose fellowship with God and are dried up.
- But ... there is practical forgiveness for fellowship.
- And ... this forgiveness is only by your repentance.

Why Is Starting Over Hard?

- Proud by nature, you hate humble confession.
- You are depraved and resent admitting wrong.
- You let Satan discourage you with fiery darts.
- You let him overwhelm you with doubts and fear.
- He makes God or us harsh and forgiveness hard.

You can start over with God any time.

No sin is too big for Him to forgive.


No sinner has too many sins to forgive.


You cannot start over too many times.

It all depends on the (R) factor!

Example of the Prodigal Son

- At all times he was the <u>legal</u> son of his father.
- But by rebellion he lost <u>fellowship</u> with his father.
- The father used "<u>dead</u>" only for lack of fellowship.
- Fellowship needs ... (1) the rebel's repentance.
- Fellowship needs ... (2) the father's forgiveness.





Example of the Prodigal Son

- The rebel truly repented ... to be a servant!
- The father truly forgave ... <u>celebrating a son</u>!
- He even corrected the older brother's envy.
- Fellowship required ... the rebel's repentance.
- Fellowship required ... the father's forgiveness.

If you have sinned, no matter how big or small, you can and should repent! Do not worry about God doing His part! He will mercifully run to meet you! Are you serious that the God we worship forgives so quickly and fully?

Our God Delights in Mercy!

Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, <u>because he delighteth in mercy</u>. Micah 7:18

- It was blown in the day of atonement! Amen!
- Total liberty was proclaimed to all of Israel!
- A year of vacation and reclaiming all assets.
- Every 7 and 50 yrs each man got to start over.
- It started with ... <u>repenting</u> on Day of Atonement.

How High Is Heaven?

- We pick the second heaven for 200B galaxies!
- Big galaxies have 100 trillion stars in orbit!
- Some galaxies are 13B light years from earth.
- How high is heaven? <u>Too high to measure</u>!
- What does this have to do with you? Read on!

Isaiah 55:7

Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

- Forsaking and returning = Repentance!
- God will have mercy on you believe it!
- God will abundantly pardon believe it!

Isaiah 55:8-9

8 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD.
9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

- God shows mercy and pardons very differently!
- As heaven's height cannot be measured, so God!
- Why would anyone doubt or fear God's mercy?

Are you serious that the God we worship forgives so quickly and fully?

Yes! He is the infinite Jehovah with abundant mercy!

Yes! He bruised and killed His Son so He could show such mercy to you!

How <u>BIG</u> of a sin can God forgive as easily as you have described?

Think aggravated adultery and murder! How <u>LITTLE</u> of a sin can God forgive as you have described?

Think Asa's high places and many men's polygamy!

- It is how our church celebrates a repenting sinner!
- We eat the best; buy him clothes, shoes, and ring!
- Sins repented of are forgotten and never recalled!
- We fulfill prodigal's father and feasts of charity!
- How did we learn this? From the Spirit and word!

What Is It? How Do I Get It?



A = Admit your sin is your fault.

R = Repudiate it as perverse folly.

C = <u>Change</u> your conduct about it.



C = Confess the sin is your fault.

A = Abandon it in every way.

R = Reform your actions about it.

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. I John 1:9

<u>I acknowledged my sin unto</u> <u>thee, and mine iniquity have I</u> <u>not hid</u>. I said, <u>I will confess my</u> <u>transgressions unto the LORD;</u> and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah. Psalm 32:5



For <u>I will declare mine iniquity</u>; <u>I will be sorry for my sin</u>.

For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me. Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.

He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy. Proverbs 28:13

I will arise and go to my father, and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee, And am no more worthy to be called thy son: make me as one of thy hired servants.

O Israel, return unto the LORD thy God; for thou hast fallen by thine iniquity. Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto him, Take away all iniquity, and receive us graciously: so will we render the calves of our lips.

If we confess our sins, <u>he is faithful and just</u> <u>to forgive us our sins,</u> <u>and to cleanse us</u> <u>from all unrighteousness</u>. IJohn 1:9

ZACCHAEUS promised restitution ... and had lunch with Jesus commending him!

A SINNER WOMAN washed Jesus' feet ... and had Jesus defend and praise her to Simon!

A THIEF confessed sins and honored Jesus ... to hear Jesus promise eternal life with Him!

Real Repentance Is a Gift!

In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. II Timothy 2:25-26

Real Repentance Is Different!

For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: <u>but the sorrow of the world</u> <u>worketh death</u>. Il Corinthians 7:10

Real Repentance Is Drastic!

For behold this selfsame thing, that ye sorrowed after a godly sort, what carefulness it wrought in you, yea, what clearing of yourselves, yea, what indignation, yea, what fear, yea, what vehement desire, yea, what zeal, yea, what revenge! II Corinthians 7:11a

Real Repentance Works!

In all things ye have approved yourselves to be clear in this matter.

Godly Sorrow that Fully Clears!



How Fast Does God Run?

And David said unto Nathan, I have sinned against the LORD. And Nathan said unto David, The LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.

How Long Does It Take?

And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom. And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise. Luke 23:42-43

Can I Still Amount to Anything?

- David continued as God's favorite of all time!
- Josiah became one of the top four all-time kings!
- Peter, in days, led the apostles, took gospel to the Gentiles, and wrote two epistles with his name!
- Four sinful women made the genealogy of our Lord – Tamar, Rahab, Ruth, and Bathsheba!

What If More Sins than One?

- DAVID ... aggravated adultery <u>and</u> murder!
- But <u>also</u> polygamy, numbered Israel, murderous anger at Nabal, moved Ark wrong, and bad father!
- PETER ... denied Jesus with oaths and cursing the night of His greatest need after promising loyalty!
- But <u>also</u> played the hypocrite at Paul's home church in Antioch of Syria for a public rebuke!

Are There Any Warnings?

- Repentance is more than temporary lip service!
- Elect do not use this gospel offer for license to sin!
- We do not chase scorners ... so show some **R** !
- God does not wait forever ... He can hide from you or judge you (Pr 29:1; Is 55:6; Rev 2:21)!
- We must honor **R** like God, or we get torment!

You can ALWAYS start over!

Our God is the God of Second Chances ... and Third Chances ... and more with <u>Repentance</u>! Full joy and peace are right around the corner!

The abundant life in Christ to fill your soul with gladness is only an R factor away!

Do you need to repent tonight?

Do not wait! Do not hesitate! Do not doubt <u>His</u> forgiveness! Do not doubt <u>our</u> forgiveness! We have all been forgiven 10,000 talents or more!

We forgive your 100 pence! Your sins do not move us! We will share gospel hope! We have all been forgiven 10,000 talents or more!

We also love mercy (Mic 6:8)! We fear God (II Cor 2:10-11)! We will forgive you! We will help you! I will help you! Full joy and peace are right around the corner!
