Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship.

Our fathers ... ye say

Each nation had their own religious tradition. Agree to disagree? Two ways to God? **No way!** This mountain or Jerusalem

Mt. Gerizim or Mt. Zion? Both were soon to be replaced by new worship. Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father.

John 4:21

The hour cometh

Jesus used the future tense for the change.

Neither ... nor yet

He ended 1500 years of OT worship in Jerusalem, telling this woman!

Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.

Samaritans are ignorant.

Their manmade religion was 500 years old and sincerely dear to them. **So what!** God revealed His religion to Israel.

Knowledge for true worship requires revelation from God, which Israel had. But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

John 4:23

And now is

Jesus used the present tense, since the change had already started.

True worshippers

God only accepts some worshippers, those in spirit and in truth.

God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

John 4:24

God is not physical.

Therefore, His worship must be nonphysical, involving the spirit.

God is a Spirit.

A divine supernatural Spirit that demands truth without error. Jesus changed Samaritan and Jewish worship to worship in spirit and truth!

Religious Change Started with John

The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man presseth into it.

Luke 16:16

Religious Change = Reformation

Which stood only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, <u>imposed on them</u> <u>until the time of reformation</u>.

Hebrews 9:10

The time of reformation was from John Baptist to the final ruin of Jerusalem. (30-70 AD)

What is worship "in spirit"?

- It is opposite most of O.T. worship in Jerusalem.
- Moses' religion was carnal, physical ... in a place.
- It had many carnal acts of outward ceremony.
- N.T. worship is to be of the heart and of the mind.
- It is an invisible worship without place or things.
- It replaces outward ritual with internal affection.

Worship "in spirit" is ... Not ...

- <u>Worship in the Holy Spirit</u>, though truly necessary.
- The Spirit was future ... but Jesus said, "now is."
- The N.T. context is change of reformation (Heb 9:10).
- <u>Worship in spirit and not the letter</u> as in Matt 5-7.
- Matt 5-7 rebuked Jewish abuse, not O.T. in truth.
- The N.T. context is change of reformation (Heb 9:10).

Worship "in spirit" surely condemned carnal Jewish worship at Jerusalem.

What did Paul call the O.T.?

Beggarly Carnal Elements Old **Rudiments** Weak Worldly

Meats and Drinks (Heb 9:10)

- The O.T. told you what you could or could not eat.
- No bacon, ham, pepperoni, salami, or sausage!
- There was a terrible potion for women to drink.
- No calamari, lobster, shrimp, oysters, or catfish!
- Peter rejected pork ribs three times in Acts 10.
- The N.T. specifically condemns forbidding meats!



Divers Washings (Heb 9:10)

- Divers = Different ... all kinds of ritual washings.
- Aaron and the priests had their unique washings.
- One week a month for women, many washings.
- Washing included body, clothes, furniture, etc.
- The Pharisees foolishly added more washings.
- The NT does not care if you wash at all, but we do!

Carnal Ordinances (Heb 9:10)

- Carnal = bodily, fleshly, physical, material.
- Carnal = not spiritual ... *not spirit worship* ... get it?
- Circumcision was very important capital crime.
- Living in a booth of sticks for a week for Egypt.
- Sacrifices galore from headless birds to scapegoats.
- Redeeming your ass by killing a lamb, etc., etc.

It's gone!

In that he saith, A <u>new</u> covenant, he hath made the first <u>old</u>. Now that which <u>decayeth and</u> <u>waxeth old is ready to</u> <u>vanish away</u>.


Hebrews 8:13

> Hebrews 9:9,14; 10:2,22 I Peter 3:21!


But many Christians bring carnal junk back in from the Jews!!!
























No pictures, incense, candles, stained glass, steeples, altar, horns, flags, robes, piano, etc.

Praying, singing, preaching the word, communion, etc.

We pray with the Spirit and with understanding.

We sing with the Spirit and with understanding.

We preach by the Spirit to the born again spirits of regenerate men.

We take communion with careful, internal self-examination and sober discernment.

With free consciences! With inflamed hearts! With informed minds!

We can do it anywhere! Buildings are for comfort! Church liberty is broad!

John 4:24

What is worship "in truth"?

- It is opposite manmade traditions of Samaritans.
- It must be by revelation of knowledge from God.
- It rejects any religious tradition against scripture.
- It esteems God's precepts and hates false ways.
- It knows God is a God of doctrine and of details.
- It ignores persons, popularity, sincerity, cost, etc.

Worship "in truth" surely condemned false manmade worship of the Samaritans.

17 Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them. 18 For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.

Romans 16:17-18

8 But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach <u>any other gospel</u> unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

9 As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach <u>any other gospel</u> unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

Galatians 1:8-9

Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold <u>the traditions which ye have been taught</u>, whether by word, or our epistle.

Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition which he received of us.

II Thessalonians 3:6

10 A man that is <u>an heretick</u> after the first and second admonition reject; 11 Knowing that he that is such is subverted, and sinneth, being condemned of himself.

With truth so crucial for the worship of God ...

... how are we sure we have the truth? These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so. Acts 17:11

<u>Prove all things</u>; hold fast that which is good.

I Thessalonians 5:21

To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them.

Isaiah 8:20

Therefore I esteem <u>all thy precepts</u> concerning all things to be right; and I hate every false way. Psalm 119:128

98 Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they are ever with me. 99 I have more understanding than all my teachers: for thy testimonies are my meditation. 100 I understand more than the ancients, because I keep thy precepts. Psalm 119:98-100



You have been taught this duty ... many times.


It is very basic to our lives as Bible Christians.


We are Bible Christians and truth for worship is only and clearly from the Bible.

World Religions by percentage



600,000,000 Charismatics/Pentecostals





Independent Baptist Probability

- Only <u>1/3</u> of the earth's population is <u>Christian</u>.
- Only <u>1/3</u> of earth's Christians are <u>Protestant</u>.
- Only <u>1/8</u> of earth's Protestants are <u>Baptists</u>.
- Only <u>1/7</u> of earth's Baptists are <u>not SBC or BWA</u>.
- Free Baptists are 1/504002% ... small remnant!

Some Laws of Small Numbers!

- In human history, only a small minority have held truth.
- Think Noah and the ark ... think 120 in an upper room.
- High esteem to men is abomination to God (Luke 16:15).
- We are warned to avoid crowds or majorities (Ex 23:2).
- A small minority by itself does not prove truth at all.
- The <u>combination</u> of our doctrine/practice is most rare.

God Cares About Details (1)

- We cannot ... add to, take away, go left, or go right!
- Nadab and Abihu with strange fire to God (Lev 10:1-7).
- David moved God's Ark on a new ox cart (II Sam 6:1-10).
- Ananias and Sapphira lied about their gift (Acts 5:1-11).
- Corinthians for altering Lord's Supper (I Cor 11:20-34).
- Think ... work ethic, hair length, women speaking, etc.

God Cares About Details (2)

- Think ... attendance, rulers, sexual defrauding, etc.
- If God cares about details, we have to care about them.
- Therefore, we must mark differences large and small.
- We are not Fundamentalists with essentials and not so.
- Interpretation differences without heresy are okay.

Easy-believism without fruit	Associations (PCA; SBC; GARBC)


Errors We Once Held (2)

A Few Enemies of Truth!



Revelation is crucial, and it is only found in the Bible, nowhere else.
