WHY?

- Ochristian saints must be <u>true</u> friends, because they are born for adversity.
- A church grows properly as each member invests in compounding growth.
- What is your sharpening reputation?
- Do you have a neutral or beneficial effect on <u>few</u> or <u>many</u> of the lives near you ?

A tree of life is NOT keeping a home.
A tree of life is NOT teaching your children cooking, laundry or art.
A tree of life is NOT, I'll pray for you.

A TREE OF LIFE IS NOT

• A tree of life is NOT attending assemblies and talking to friends.

• A tree of life is NOT helping others move, taking a meal, or babysitting.

• A tree of life is NOT making sure your children graduate.

A tree of life IS: helping perfect another to grow spiritually, in favor with God and man, and to hold fast their profession of faith without wavering until Jesus comes.

SELFISHNESS

Some love themselves too much to care for others.

- It is a rule of Christ's religion for us to more highly consider others.
- You can spot a selfish person. Listen. They can only talk about themselves.

SELFISHNESS

It is a mark of self-love to serve those who can return the favor.
Selfless service seeks out the helpless.
Such people will never do anything for anyone that might personally cost them.
Look for excuses or thinking like Cain, "Am I my brother's keeper?"

SLOTHFULNESS

• Being a tree of life to others requires much time and effort.

- Ministering to other saints is called a work and labor by brother Paul.
- Everyone finds time for their own things, and we must find it for one another.

FEAR

• Some are so fearful of correcting another they will compromise with sin. • There is a mechanism to handle anyone not receiving correction. • If we fear losing a friend, we have neither faith nor love. • We are all sinners, but that doesn't mean we should not correct others.

IGNORANCE

• Growth requires craving the Word of God and preaching.

 If you have not hid God's word in your heart, then you have nothing to offer.

• Not considering others loses opportunities.

She openeth her mouth with wisdom; and in her tongue is the law of kindness.
