#### We Are Bible Christians ... Four Ways!

We believe what it claims about its inspiration!

We believe 66 books of the KJV by <u>canonicity</u>!

We believe word-level truth by preservation.

We give the sense by its rules of *interpretation*.

Our confidence in all four facts of faith are by the power of God! 17 (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and <u>calleth those things which be not as though they were</u>.

18 Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, <u>according to that which was spoken</u>, So shall thy seed be.

The First Rule of Hermeneutics

### The Bible Has No Contradictions

Starting with the Large Context

We first prove what a verse cannot mean!

Then and only then do we try to find its true and proper sense.

### We used this rule of Bible study at least twice on Sunday.

19 We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

This is our first rule of Bible study.

#### 20 <u>Knowing this first, that no prophecy of</u> <u>the scripture is of any private interpretation</u>.

II Peter 1:19-21

### No Contradictions – Il Peter 1:20

- We accept this as the first rule, for God gave it to us.
- **<u>Private</u>**. Separate, alone, individual, peculiar, special.
- No part of scripture can contradict the whole Bible.
- There are no contradictions. We reconcile all parts.
- Why? Because its 40 writers wrote for One Author!
- We assume at all times that every part fits perfectly.

#### 20 <u>Knowing this first, that no prophecy of</u> <u>the scripture is of any private interpretation</u>.

II Peter 1:19-21

God forbid: yea, <u>let God be true, but every</u> <u>man a liar</u>; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged. Romans 3:4

### No Contradictions – Romans 3:4

- We start interpretation trusting God's truthfulness.
- Any contradiction is man's ignorance or confusion.
- We accept the premise the Bible is totally perfect.
- Interpretation finds solutions exalting Bible integrity.
- Any contradictions remaining are our fault, not His.
- We reject any thoughts that the text is the problem.

7 For my mouth shall speak <u>truth</u>; and wickedness is an abomination to my lips.
8 All the words of my mouth are in <u>righteousness</u>; there is <u>nothing froward or perverse</u> in them.
9 They are all plain to him that

9 They are <u>all plain</u> to him that understandeth, and <u>right</u> to them that find knowledge.

Proverbs 8:7-9

### No Contradictions – Proverbs 8:7-9

- There is nothing untrue, froward, or perverse in it.
- Knowledge and understanding make all plain / right.
- Confusion or problems are always our ignorance.

34 Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods?
35 If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and <u>the scripture cannot be broken</u>;

John 10:34-35
#### No Contradictions – John 10:34-35

- Jesus said that scripture cannot be broken. Glory!
- Every word may be confidently trusted without error.
- We use this verse to show arguing individual words.
- No matter what we find, we trust it to be fully true.
- Anything that looks like a contradiction is our fault.
- We love false Bibles, since they are so easy to break!

I have not written unto you because ye know not the truth, but because ye know it, and that <u>no lie is of the truth</u>.

I John 2:21

#### No Contradictions – I John 2:21

- The trust is just that ... the truth! It cannot have a lie.
- God's word is truth ... and it does not have any lies.
- What appears to be a lie is just that an apparition.
- It is our job to always reconcile any apparent lies.
- We cannot help the NIV with Goliath or Mark 1:2!

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# Why is this our first rule of Bible study?

### Why Is This Our First Rule?

- Because we were told it is by God in II Peter 1:20!
- Each verse must be limited to only possible solutions.
- If we do not start here, then possibilities are infinite.
- The single greatest restraint on heresy is this rule.
- This rule limits possible senses for the other rules.
- With all obvious errors rejected, verses get plainer.

# What can happen if we ignore this rule?

I am distressed for thee, my brother Jonathan: very pleasant hast thou been unto me: <u>thy love to me was wonderful, passing</u> <u>the love of women</u>.

II Samuel 1:26

II Samuel 1:26 could be used to prove David and Jonathan were sodomites! Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. John 8:44 could be used to teach Satan had sex with Eve for British-Israelism!

#### Look not thou upon the wine when it is red, when it giveth his colour in the cup, when it moveth itself aright.

Proverbs 23:31

Proverbs 23:31 could revive a Temperance Movement against all alcohol! So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, <u>He that is</u> <u>without sin among you</u>, let him first cast a stone at her.

John 8:7

## John 8:7 could end all judgment, since no one is without sin!

How do we apply this first rule of study? All verses for any subject must be reconciled.

We do not value some verses over others, like Martin Luther rejecting the book of James. Our two-step method <u>first</u> rules out what a verse cannot mean by the rest of the Bible.

<u>Then and only then</u> do we apply the rest of the rules of hermeneutics to find its positive sense.

Did you catch our two-step method? Our two-step method <u>first</u> rules out what a verse cannot mean by the rest of the Bible.

<u>Then and only then</u> do we apply the rest of the rules of hermeneutics to find its positive sense.

We must always reject the dishonest tendency to choose only scriptures agreeing with us.

Arminians do this with John 3:16 and Rev 3:20.

This is the road to heresy on any subject.

It is the total message of scripture that is truth.

Heresies due to ignoring this rule are Legion. And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, <u>all the land of Canaan, for an</u> <u>everlasting possession</u>; and I will be their God.

Genesis 17:8

## Genesis 17:8 cannot teach God owes land to Israel!

#### And now why tarriest thou? arise, and <u>be</u> <u>baptized</u>, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.

Acts 22:16

## Acts 22:16 cannot teach baptismal salvation of Saul!

And when they saw him, they were amazed: and his mother said unto him, Son, why hast thou thus dealt with us? behold, <u>thy father</u> and I have sought thee sorrowing.

### Luke 2:48 cannot teach Joseph was Jesus' father!

Else what shall they do which are <u>baptized</u> for the dead, if the dead rise not at all? why are they then <u>baptized for the dead</u>?

## I Corinthians 15:29 cannot teach baptism for dead relatives!

#### Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; <u>ye</u> <u>are fallen from grace</u>.

Galatians 5:4

## Galatians 5:4 cannot teach you can lose eternal life!

But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and <u>ye need not that any</u> <u>man teach you</u>: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.

I John 2:27

## I John 2:27 cannot teach that teachers are unnecessary!

This rule is ignored and abused even worse.
**Baptismal regenerationists assume the heresy by their private interpretation of Acts 22:16.** 

Then they change <u>filth</u> of the <u>flesh</u> in I Peter 3:21 to <u>dirt of the body</u> to force agreement! Some believe baptismal membership by their private interpretation of Acts 2:41.

Then they force the poor Ethiopian eunuch into the Jerusalem Church he knows nothing of!

Those obsessed with God's love for all men do so by their private interpretation of John 3:16.

Then they force Romans 9:13 to mean that God just loved Esau a little less than Jacob! Do you see how neglecting this rule leads to heresy? They find a sound bite in the Bible and put a meaning on it against the rest of the Bible.

Then they read every verse on that subject in the "light" of their one corrupted verse!

We do the very opposite of them!

### We study all Bible verses for any subject and limit every Bible verse to that overall doctrine!

## Are there Difficulties with this Rule?

- We study the whole Bible for right presuppositions!
- All verses on a given topic must be honestly studied.
- God inspired sufficient obstacles to save from heresy.
- After all, He put this rule first. He will bless its use.
- God's providence will provide an Elihu or Philip.
- Consider how God saved us from foot washing.

We have only learned what a verse cannot mean!

## Only what a Verse Cannot Mean?

- That is true! You grasp the purpose of the first rule!
- But it limits study to just a few possible solutions.
- With possibilities limited, the other rules work well.
- Do not forget this first rule of interpreting verses.
- We find the context and doctrine of the whole Bible.
- Then and only then do we move to the small context.

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Then and only then do we try to find its true and proper sense. So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, <u>He that is</u> <u>without sin among you</u>, let him first cast a stone at her.

John 8:7
