#### Zealous: Defined

Definition: having or showing zeal.

 Synonyms: fervent, ardent, fervid, fanatical, passionate, impassioned, devout, devoted, committed, dedicated, hard-core, enthusiastic, eager, keen, avid, vigorous, energetic, intense, fierce

#### Zeal: Defined

Zeal. Intense ardour in the pursuit of some end; passionate eagerness in favour of a person or cause; enthusiasm as displayed in action.

Ardour. Heat of passion or desire, vehemence, ardent desire; warmth of emotion, zeal, fervour.


