## Jesus and "I Am" in the Gospel of John

"And Moses said unto God, Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? what shall I say unto them? And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you." Exodus 3:13-14

*"Jesus said unto her,* <u>*I am the resurrection, and the life*</u>: *he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live."* 

John 11:25

5:43 ... **I am come in my Father's name**, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.

6:35 ... And Jesus said unto them, **<u>I am the bread of life</u>**: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

6:51 ... <u>I am the living bread which came down from heaven</u>: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

8:12 ... Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, **<u>I am the light of the world</u>**: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

8:16 ... And yet if I judge, my judgment is true: for <u>I am not alone</u>, but I and the Father that sent me.

8:18 ... **I am one that bear witness of myself**, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me.

8:23 ... And he said unto them, Ye are from beneath; <u>**I** am from above</u>: ye are of this world; <u>**I** am not of this world</u>.

8:24 ... I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that **<u>I am he</u>**, ye shall die in your sins.

8:28 ... Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that  $\underline{I \text{ am } he}$ , and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.

8:58 ... Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, <u>I am</u>.

9:5 ... As long as I am in the world, <u>I am the light of the world</u>.

9:39 ... And Jesus said, <u>For judgment I am come into this world</u>, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.

10:7 ... Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, <u>I am the</u> <u>door of the sheep</u>.

10:9 ... **<u>I am the door</u>**: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

10:10 ... The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: <u>I am</u> <u>come that they might have life</u>, and that they might have it more abundantly.

10:11 ... **I am the good shepherd**: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

10:14 ... **I am the good shepherd**, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.

10:36 ... Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, <u>I am the Son of God?</u>

11:25 ... Jesus said unto her, <u>I am the resurrection, and the life</u>: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

12:46 ... **I am come a light into the world**, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.

13:19 ... Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that **<u>I am he</u>**.

13:13 ... Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.

14:3 ... And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; **<u>that where I am</u>**, there ye may be also.

14:6 ... Jesus saith unto him, <u>I am the way, the truth, and the life</u>: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

14:10 ... Believest thou not that **I am in the Father**, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

14:20 ... At that day ye shall know that <u>I am in my Father</u>, and ye in me, and I in you.

16:32 ... Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet **<u>I am not alone</u>**, because the Father is with me.

15:1 ... **<u>I am the true vine</u>**, and my Father is the husbandman.

15:5 ... **<u>I am the vine</u>**, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

17:14 ... I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as **I am not of the world**.

17:16 ... They are not of the world, even as **<u>I am not of the world</u>**.

18:6 ... As soon then as he had said unto them, **<u>I am he</u>**, they went backward, and fell to the ground.

18:37 ... Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that **I am a king**. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.
