Isaiah 40-48 for the Glory of God

Boasting About God ...

could be you boasting about Him ...

or God boasting about Himself.

My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the humble shall hear thereof, and be glad.

Psalm 34:2

In God we boast all the day long, and praise thy name for ever. Selah. Psalm 44:8

Boasting about God is not sin. It is praise and worship. The Bible exhorts us to it!

Boasting about yourself is not sin, <u>if</u> true, <u>if</u> by God, and <u>if</u> for a godly reason. Both David and Paul did.

For by thee I have run through a troop; and by my God have I leaped over a wall.

Psalm 18:29

But <u>by the grace of God</u> I am what I am: and <u>his grace</u> which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, <u>but the grace of God</u> which was with me. I Corinthians 15:10 If you do not delight in God like David and others did, then this study will bore you.

Delighting in God ... boasting about Him to yourself, others, and Him ... is something He loves and is life's greatest pleasure. One way to measure your love of God is to see how excited you get when you read Him boasting of His greatness!

Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

Psalm 37:4

23 Thus saith the LORD, Let not the wise man <u>glory in his wisdom</u>, neither let the mighty man <u>glory in his might</u>, let not the rich man <u>glory in his riches</u>:

24 <u>But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me</u>, that I am the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: <u>for in these things I delight</u>, <u>saith the LORD</u>.

Jeremiah 9:23-24

If you do not delight in God's words like David and others, this study will bore you.

These 9 chapters and 216 verses are the largest section from God about Himself!

Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.

Isaiah 44:6

<u>I am the LORD</u>: that is my name: and <u>my glory will I not give to</u> <u>another</u>, neither my praise to graven images. _{Isaiah 42:8} For mine own sake, even for mine own sake, will I do it: for how should my name be polluted? and I will not give my glory unto another.

Isaiah 48:11

Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after <u>me</u>.

Isaiah 43:10

Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? <u>ye are even my witnesses</u>. Is there a God beside me? <u>yea, there is no God; I know not any</u>. Isaiah 44:8

Remember the former things of old: for <u>I am God, and there is none</u> <u>else; I am God, and there is none like me</u>,

Isaiah 46:9

God boasting about Himself is not sin in any way at all. It is true and righteous.

It is how He reveals Himself, mocks false religion, rebukes doubters, humbles and comforts us. Isaiah 40-48 is about God, mostly God speaking in the first person about Himself. The context is God's chastening of His people by their captivity in Babylon, but He would rescue them from that great city by the yet unknown Cyrus the Persian. He warned His people and the Babylonians that any confidence in idols was worthless, for He alone was God and would do as He chose among all the earth's nations. These nine chapters have a total of 96 occurrences of ... I ... the first person singular pronoun! Mine hand also hath laid the foundation of the earth, and my right hand hath spanned the heavens: when <u>I</u> call unto them, they stand up together.

Isaiah 48:13

Remember the former things of old: for <u>I</u> am God, and there is none else; <u>I</u> am God, and there is none like me, Isaiah 46:9

I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these things.

Isaiah 45:7

<u>I</u> have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: <u>I</u> said not unto the seed of Jacob, Seek ye me in vain: <u>I</u> the LORD speak righteousness, <u>I</u> declare things that are right.

Isaiah 45:19

And even to your old age <u>I</u> am he; and even to hoar hairs will <u>I</u> carry you: <u>I</u> have made, and <u>I</u> will bear; even <u>I</u> will carry, and will deliver you. Isaiah 46:4 These eight chapters have a total of

96 occurrences of ... I
42 occurrences of ... my
33 occurrences of ... me
9 occurrences of ... mine
4 occurrences of ... myself

The main event in this section of scripture that God boasted about was sending Cyrus the Persian to rebuild His city and temple. God called Cyrus by name and detailed great things Cyrus would accomplish ...

150 years before Cyrus was born!
Who raised up the righteous man from the east, called him to his foot, gave the nations before him, and made him rule over kings? he gave them as the dust to his sword, and as driven stubble to his bow. Isaiah 41:2 14 All ye, assemble yourselves, and hear; which among them hath declared these things? <u>The LORD hath loved him</u>: he will do his pleasure on Babylon, and his arm shall be on the Chaldeans. 15 I, even I, have spoken; <u>yea, I have called him: I have brought him, and he shall make his way prosperous</u>.

Isaiah 48:14-15

Being able to foretell the future in detail and bring it to pass is the greatest proof of the existence and revelation of God. No other God or holy book has fulfilled prophecies.

Jehovah and the Bible are unique.

Our GOD Jehovah is the only true and living God, and He is our loving Father.

Pastor, why did you include Isaiah 40, if the references to Cyrus are only in chapters 41-48? Fear thou not; for <u>I</u> am with thee: be not dismayed; for <u>I</u> am thy God: <u>I</u> will strengthen thee; yea, <u>I</u> will help thee; yea, <u>I</u> will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

God boasts ...

Mankind on earth is like grasshoppers to Him!

It is he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and <u>the inhabitants</u> <u>thereof are as grasshoppers</u>; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in Isaiah 40:22





Do not be offended!

Grasshoppers are actually a very kind comparison for us rebel sinners.

God boasts ...

I do whatever I want, and no one can hinder me!

Yea, before the day was I am he; and <u>there is none that can deliver out</u> of my hand: I will work, and <u>who shall let it</u>?

Isaiah 43:13

God boasts ...

I am God exclusively, there is no other being like me!
Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; <u>I am God, and there is none like me</u>,

Isaiah 46:9

There is no God like me, since there are no others!

That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that there is none beside me. I am the LORD, and there is none else.

Isaiah 45:6

He designed the earth with purpose ... to be inhabited!

For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, <u>he formed it to be inhabited</u>: I am the LORD; and there is none else.

Isaiah 45:18

He frustrates false prophets and makes diviners mad! That <u>frustrateth</u> the tokens of the liars, and <u>maketh</u> diviners mad; that <u>turneth</u> wise men backward, and <u>maketh</u> their knowledge foolish; Isaiah 44:25

The earth is circular; it is not flat, nor is it square!

It is he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in: Isaiah 40:22

Idolaters are stupid! They use leftover wood for a god! 16 <u>He burneth part</u> thereof in the fire; <u>with part thereof he eateth</u> <u>flesh</u>; he roasteth roast, and is satisfied: yea, he warmeth himself, and saith, Aha, I am warm, I have seen the fire:

17 <u>And the residue thereof he maketh a god</u>, even his graven image: he falleth down unto it, and worshippeth it, and prayeth unto it, and saith, Deliver me; for thou art my god. Isaiah 44:16-17











The LORD God has blinded and deceived them so they cannot see or understand, so they might be vanity and ashamed. Isaiah 44:9-20 II Thess 2:9-12

I am exclusively God, and there is no other God!

Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? ye are even my witnesses. <u>Is there a God beside me?</u> yea, there is no God; I know not any. Isaiah 44:8

All men are like grass, even the best of men will wither. 6 <u>All flesh is grass</u>, and all the goodliness thereof is as the flower of the field:

7 The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: because the spirit of the LORD bloweth upon it: <u>surely the people is grass</u>.

Isaiah 40:6-7

God can blow for or against you. Think Joseph – from prison to throne. Think Pharaoh – from throne to Red Sea.

If you obey me, I can give profit, peace, and progeny.

17 I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.
18 O that thou hadst hearkened to my commandments! then had thy peace been as a river, and thy righteousness as the waves of the sea:
19 Thy seed also had been as the sand, and the offspring of thy bowels like the gravel thereof; his name should not have been cut off nor destroyed from before me.

Isaiah 48:17-19

True good news is when men yell, Behold your God! O Zion, that bringest <u>good tidings</u>, get thee up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, that bringest <u>good tidings</u>, lift up thy voice with strength; lift it up, be not afraid; say unto the cities of Judah, <u>Behold your God</u>! Isaiah 40:9 The context is the gospel in the times of Messiah – Jesus Christ – who was beheld as the only begotten Son of God.

When I call earth and stars, they stand up to obey me! Mine hand also hath laid the foundation of the earth, and my right hand hath spanned the heavens: when I call unto them, they stand up together.

Isaiah 48:13

No one taught me any of my infinite understanding!

13 Who hath <u>directed the Spirit of the LORD</u>, or being his counsellor hath <u>taught him</u>?

14 With whom <u>took he counsel</u>, and who <u>instructed him</u>, and <u>taught</u> <u>him</u> in the path of judgment, and <u>taught him</u> knowledge, and <u>shewed</u> <u>to him</u> the way of understanding?

Isaiah 40:13-14

I will deliver you out of Babylon only for my praise! 9 For my name's sake will I defer mine anger, and for my praise will I refrain for thee, that I cut thee not off....

11 For <u>mine own sake</u>, even for <u>mine own sake</u>, will I do it: for how should <u>my name be polluted</u>? and <u>I will not give my glory</u> unto another.

Isaiah 48:9-11

All nations are a drop of a bucket and less than nothing!

15 Behold, the nations are as a drop of a bucket, and are counted as the small dust of the balance: behold, he taketh up the isles as a very little thing....

17 <u>All nations before him</u> are as nothing; and they are counted to him less than nothing, and vanity.

Isaiah 40:15-17






One drop of water is irrelevant to the contents of a five-gallon bucket, just like all earth's nations are also irrelevant, even America. 15 Behold, the nations are as a drop of a bucket, <u>and are counted as</u> <u>the small dust of the balance</u>: behold, he taketh up the isles as a very little thing....

17 <u>All nations before him</u> are as nothing; and they are counted to him less than nothing, and vanity.

Isaiah 40:15-17



Dust on a scale is irrelevant when weighing with metal weights, just like all earth's nations are also irrelevant, even America.

Have continual meetings; I will burn your counselors up! 12 Stand now with thine <u>enchantments</u>, and with the multitude of thy <u>sorceries</u>, wherein thou hast laboured from thy youth; if so be thou shalt be able to profit, if so be thou mayest prevail.

13 Thou art wearied in the multitude of thy <u>counsels</u>. Let now the <u>astrologers</u>, the <u>stargazers</u>, the <u>monthly prognosticators</u>, stand up, and save thee from these things that shall come upon thee.

14 <u>Behold, they shall be as stubble; the fire shall burn them</u>; they shall not deliver themselves from the power of the flame: there shall not be a coal to warm at, nor fire to sit before it.

Isaiah 47:12-14

Babylon took every precaution to protect their city, holding numerous meetings with their best advisors, but God promised to burn the whole mess up.

All the wood and beasts are not enough for my sacrifice!

And <u>Lebanon is not sufficient to burn</u>, nor the beasts thereof sufficient for a burnt offering.

Isaiah 40:16







I used you to chasten, and now I will abuse you for it! 6 <u>I was wroth with my people</u>, I have polluted mine inheritance, and given them into thine hand: thou didst shew them no mercy; upon the ancient hast thou very heavily laid thy yoke.

7 And thou saidst, <u>I shall be a lady for ever</u>: so that thou didst not lay these things to thy heart, neither didst remember the latter end of it. 11 <u>Therefore shall evil come upon thee</u>; thou shalt not know from whence it riseth: and mischief shall fall upon thee; thou shalt not be able to put it off: and desolation shall come upon thee suddenly, which thou shalt not know.

Isaiah 47:6-11

God used Babylon to chasten Israel for 70 years, and then He purposed to abuse them for their haughty role in it.

> Compare Isaiah 10:5-19. Grasp Romans 9:19-20.

I have created, numbered, named, and kept the stars! 25 <u>To whom then will ye liken me</u>, or shall I be equal? saith the Holy One.

26 Lift up your eyes on high, and behold who hath <u>created</u> these things, that bringeth out their host by <u>number</u>: he calleth them all by <u>names</u> by the greatness of his might, for that he is strong in power; <u>not one faileth</u>.

Isaiah 40:25-26



I am not like men; your beauty does not move me! 1 Come down, and sit in the dust, O virgin daughter of Babylon, sit on the ground: there is no throne, O daughter of the Chaldeans: <u>for thou</u> <u>shalt no more be called tender and delicate</u>.

2 Take the millstones, and grind meal: uncover thy locks, make bare the leg, uncover the thigh, pass over the rivers.

3 Thy nakedness shall be uncovered, yea, thy shame shall be seen: I will take vengeance, and <u>I will not meet thee as a man</u>.

Isaiah 47:1-3

You did not choose me as your God; I chose you! 8 But thou, Israel, art my servant, Jacob whom <u>I have chosen</u>, the seed of Abraham my friend.

9 Thou whom <u>I have taken</u> from the ends of the earth, and <u>called thee</u> from the chief men thereof, and said unto thee, Thou art my servant; <u>I have chosen thee</u>, and not cast thee away.

I determine the future, and I make it happen as I please! 10 Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, <u>My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure</u>:

11 Calling a ravenous bird from the east, the man that executeth my counsel from a far country: yea, <u>I have spoken it</u>, <u>I will also bring it to</u> pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it.

Isaiah 46:10-11

You are a worm to me, but I will hold your hand to help!

13 For I the LORD thy God <u>will hold thy right hand</u>, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee.

14 Fear not, <u>thou worm Jacob</u>, and ye men of Israel; <u>I will help thee</u>, saith the LORD, and thy redeemer, the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 41:13-14

I carried you from birth; I will carry you in old age! 3 Hearken unto me, O house of Jacob, and all the remnant of the house of Israel, which are borne by me from the belly, which are carried from the womb:

4 And even to your old age I am he; and even to hoar hairs <u>will I carry</u> you: I have made, and <u>I will bear</u>; even <u>I will carry</u>, and will deliver you. Isaiah 46:3-4

Though we sing this promise in the song,

How Firm a Foundation,

you must see the context for full meaning!

And when hoary hairs shall their temples adorn,

Like lambs they shall still in my bosom be borne.

Babylon's gods must be carried, and they are heavy!

1 Bel boweth down, Nebo stoopeth, their idols were upon the beasts, and upon the cattle: <u>your carriages were heavy loaden; they are a</u> <u>burden to the weary beast</u>.

2 They stoop, they bow down together; they could not deliver the burden, but themselves are gone into captivity.

Isaiah 46:1-2

Our God, the Creator of heaven and earth, carries us through the days of our lives, but pagan gods must be carried, and they cannot save any.

Bring your best arguments and let us begin a debate!
<u>Produce your cause</u>, saith the LORD; <u>bring forth your strong reasons</u>, saith the King of Jacob.

Isaiah 41:21

If you think this a minor point, think again:

It summarizes these nine chapters well.
 It is my favorite against all human ideas.

I am the infinite Creator, but I am truly knowable! 18 For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else.

19 <u>I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I said not</u> <u>unto the seed of Jacob, Seek ye me in vain</u>: I the LORD speak righteousness, I declare things that are right. _{Isaiah 45:18-19} Pagan gods are worshipped by esoteric religion with an exclusive priesthood that alone is given the mysteries of the deity. Our God is knowable ... offers personal fellowship to His people ... and would never mislead them about such a thing.

No god or man can foretell the future perfectly like me! 21 Produce your cause, saith the LORD; bring forth your strong reasons, saith the King of Jacob.

22 Let them bring them forth, and shew us what shall happen: let them shew the former things, what they be, that we may consider them, and know the latter end of them; or declare us things for to come.

23 <u>Shew the things that are to come hereafter, that we may know that</u> <u>ye are gods</u>: yea, do good, or do evil, that we may be dismayed, and behold it together.

Isaiah 41:21-23

There is nothing like fulfilled prophecy to prove the existence of God and/or the validity of His revelation. To foretell the future requires omniscience of all first and secondary causes and/or the ability to rule them for a determined end.

7 They are created now, and not from the beginning; even before the day when thou heardest them not; <u>lest thou shouldest say, Behold, I</u> <u>knew them</u>.

Cyrus will do my will exactly with no personal reward! I have raised him up in righteousness, and I will direct all his ways: he shall build my city, and he shall let go my captives, <u>not for price nor</u> <u>reward</u>, saith the LORD of hosts.

Isaiah 45:13

Any that worships another god is an abomination!

Behold, ye are of nothing, and your work of nought: <u>an abomination is</u> <u>he that chooseth you</u>.

Isaiah 41:24

Question me to your ruin; fight other shards, shard! Woe unto him that striveth with his Maker! Let the potsherd strive with the potsherds of the earth. Shall the clay say to him that fashioneth it, What makest thou? or thy work, He hath no hands? Isaiah 45:9





I do not share my glory with any man, angel, or an idol! I am the LORD: that is my name: and <u>my glory will I not give to</u> <u>another</u>, neither my praise to graven images. Isaiah 42:8

I named you, Cyrus, and girded you without you!

4 For Jacob my servant's sake, and Israel mine elect, <u>I have even called</u> thee by thy name: I have surnamed thee, though thou hast not known me.

5 I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside me: <u>I</u> girded thee, though thou hast not known me:

6 That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that there is none beside me. <u>I am the LORD, and there is none else</u>.

Isaiah 45:4-6

God named Cyrus and foretold his overthrow of Babylon about 150 years before Cyrus was even born. This is one of the greatest prophecies in the Bible for several reasons, and it has a large role in Isaiah 40-48.








I hold back when I want to, and I wreck havoc at once. 14 I have long time holden my peace; <u>I have been still, and refrained</u> <u>myself</u>: now will I cry like a travailing woman; <u>I will destroy and devour</u> <u>at once</u>.

15 I will make waste mountains and hills, and dry up all their herbs; and I will make the rivers islands, and I will dry up the pools. Isaiah 42:14-15

Cyrus, I worked the exploits of your taking of Babylon!

1 Thus saith the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand <u>I</u> <u>have holden</u>, to subdue nations before him; and <u>I will</u> loose the loins of kings, to open before him the two leaved gates; and the gates shall not be shut;

2 <u>I will</u> go before thee, and make the crooked places straight: <u>I will</u> break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron:
