Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall <u>depart from the faith</u>, giving heed to seducing spirits, and <u>doctrines of devils</u>;

I Timothy 4:1

- The Holy Spirit told Paul plainly about some heresies coming in the last times.
- Some Christians would depart from the true religion of the apostles of Jesus.
- They would listen to seducing spirits devils rather than to God's written word.
- They would follow doctrines of devils rather than follow God's written word.
- Paul had warned that this would happen (II Cor 11:3-4,13-15; II Thess 2:9-12; II Tim 3:6-7).

Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

I Timothy 4:2

- How could a Christian pastor ever turn from the apostolic truth to lies of the devil?
- By hypocrisy ... pretending to represent Jesus Christ ... but preaching lies instead.
- By choosing fear and love of men ... their consciences became dead to conviction.
- This can still happen, which is why reminders must be made of most-popular lies.
- Pastor, what are the lies that Christians would leave the truth to preach instead?

Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.

I Timothy 4:3


- They would preach that marriage was wrong in order to please God more.

Abstaining from meat is why public schools served fish on Fridays in most states.



Did you notice that Catholics use two words ... <u>fasting</u> and <u>abstinence</u>?

Fasting is eating one regular full meal and two small meals on Ash Wednesday and also Good Friday.

<u>Abstinence</u> is not consuming meat in your diet or meals. A good alternative is fish.

Catholics call it <u>abstinence</u> to make sure you know they are the heretics of I Tim 4:3. Forbidding to marry, and commanding to <u>abstain from meats</u>, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.

I Timothy 4:3

Dietary laws for Christians is false doctrine from the devil and was rejected by Paul. 4 For every creature of God is good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving:

I Timothy 4:4-5 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: Colossians 2:16 20 Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances, 21 (Touch not; taste not; handle not;

22 Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men?

23 Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh.

Dietary laws of Leviticus were for the Jews under Moses, not for Christians.

II Thessalonians 2:3

4 And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:

5 And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

6 And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: <u>and when I saw her, I</u> wondered with great admiration.

Revelation 17:4-6

Revelation 17 foretold the RCC and its popes as a church, a woman.

What is a sacrament?

The word is not used in the Bible, so we want to know what Catholics mean by their use of the word.

A sacrament is a Christian rite viewed as of particular importance and significance.

A sacrament is an outward sign that conveys inward grace to save the soul.

A sacrament is a religious ritual to impart God's grace necessary for eternal life.

An outward sign of inward grace instituted by Christ to work sanctification.

THE SEVEN SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM Sacrament of Initiation

The Sacrament of Baptism is the first step in a lifelong journey of commitment and discipleship. Whether we are baptized as infants or adults, Baptism is the Church's way of celebrating and enacting the embrace of Cod.

RECONCILIATION Sacrament of Healing

The Sacrament of Reconciliation (also known as Penance) has three elements: conversion, confession and celebration. In it we find God's unconditional forgiveness; as a result we are called to forgive others.

HOLY ORDERS Sacrament of Service

In the Sacrament of Holy Orders, or Ordination, the priest being ordained vows to lead other Catholics by bringing them the sacraments, by proclaiming the Cospel, and by providing other means to holiness. Sacra

CONFIRMATION Sacrament of Initiation

Confirmation is a Sacrament of mature

commitment and a deepening of baptismal gifts. It is one of the three Sacraments of Initiations. It is most often associated with the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

MATRIMONY

Sacrament of Service

The Sacrament of Marriage is a public sign that one gives oneself totally to this other person. It is also a public statement about God: the loving union of husband and wife speaks of family values and also God's values.

EUCHARIST Sacrament of Initiation

Catholics believe the Eucharist, or Communion, is both a sacrifice and a meal. We believe in the real presence of Jesus, who died for our sins. As we receive Christ's Body and Blood, we also are nourished spiritually and brought closer to God.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK Sacrament of Healing

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, formerly known as Last Rites or Extreme Unction, is a ritual of healing appropriate not only for physical but also for mental and spiritual sickness.



Sacramentalism is conditional salvation depending on use of the sacraments.

Sacramentalism requires sinners to do religious rites to get and keep eternal life.

While a sacrament is a symbol of grace, it is also the means of obtaining grace.

While God is not bound to use sacraments in giving grace, it is His ordinary means.

The external thing or action is the "matter," and the words are called the "form."

Protestants and Reformers agree with us about sacraments as their creeds declare.

There were seven sacraments instituted by Jesus Christ, and this number cannot be changed. Protestants and Reformers usually reduce them to two ... baptism and communion.

Real Baptists hate the word sacrament. Any Baptist using it is a heretic.

Real Baptists know Jesus ordained signs like baptism, but they do not give grace.

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BAPTISM

Pour water on infant foreheads to wash away original sin and regenerate them.

CONFIRMATION

Laying on of hands to give the Holy Ghost for grace in bold faith and new character.

MASS

The priest turns a cracker into Jesus, offers Him to God, and then allows communion.

PENANCE

After confessing mortal sins to a priest, he forgives your sins and assigns a penance.

LAST RITES

Anointing the sick is usually for dying – extreme unction. It forgives sins for heaven.

MATRIMONY

A priest binds a man and woman in perpetual marriage in a RC church.

ORDERS

This is the ordination of men to the offices of bishop, priest, or deacon.

Mother Church Seduction

Observe how she claims power over human souls from before birth (fetal baptism) through death and even beyond (time in purgatory).

Mother Church Seduction

The cycle starts all over again with a Catholic wedding that leads to another child baptism, first communion, confirmation, and a wedding again.

The Council of Trent

A RCC council from 1545-1563 to oppose the Reformation by issuing curses (anathemas) against those preaching truth against her lies.

The RCC whore was drunk with the blood of the saints by tyrants like Bloody Mary. If anyone says that the sacraments of the New Law were not instituted by Jesus Christ, our Lord; or that they are more or less than seven, or that any one of the seven is not truly and properly a sacrament,

If anyone says that the sacraments of the New Law are not necessary for salvation and that, without them, men obtain from God through faith alone the grace of justification ...

If anyone says that the sacraments of the New Law do not contain the grace which they signify ...

If anyone says that grace, as far as God is concerned, is not given through the sacraments always and to all men,

If anyone says that in baptism, confirmation and holy orders there is not imprinted on the soul a character, a spiritual and indelible sign which means that they cannot be repeated,

If anyone says that all Christians can administer the word and the sacraments,

If anyone says that the approved rites of the Catholic Church, used in the administration of the sacraments, may be despised, omitted, or changed,

A proof of Baptist perpetuity from the apostles is enemies naming heresies we believe. Do you love your Baptist fathers that said the sacraments were not instituted by Christ, are not necessary for salvation, do not contain grace, and may be despised and omitted?

Our Baptist fathers in the faith defied Rome about the Sacraments and died for it. In the name of Jesus Christ my Lord, I despise, mock, and trample on the SEVEN SACRAMENTS of the Roman Whore and her brothel.

Why do modern Baptists think the church has two ordinances? From whom? Every command of Jesus Christ for us to follow is truly an ordinance, not just baptism and the Lord's Supper. And as they went through the cities, they delivered them the <u>decrees</u> for to keep, that were ordained of the apostles and elders which were at Jerusalem.

Acts 16:4

Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation.

Even so hath the Lord ordained that they which preach the gospel should live of the gospel.

I Corinthians 9:14

Now I praise you, brethren, that ye remember me in all things, and <u>keep the ordinances</u>, as I delivered them to you.

I Corinthians 11:2

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Ephesians 2:10

Baptism is not an ordinance of the church anyway. It is a ministerial ordinance.

Where does this exaltation of two ordinances come from?

They follow Rome and her harlot daughter churches and their sacraments though using the word ordinances.

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














Roman Catholic baptism is an abomination to God for three very large reasons.

Bible baptism is totally different!

It <u>does not save</u> from sins. It is <u>only for believers</u>. It is <u>only by immersion</u>.







It washes away original and mortal sins. It regenerates a person as a child of God. It makes infants members of the Church. It is the only sacrament for original sin. It saves a person both legally and vitally. Baptism of desire and blood cover all. Intrauterine baptism is also done.



Three ways – affusion, aspersion, immersion.
They practiced immersion for 1000 years.
Affusion and aspersion ... lack of water.
Affusion and aspersion ... for sickly.
They use affusion (pouring) today.
Presbies aspersion (sprinkling).
A Legion of more inventions.

The water must be poured on the forehead. The formula is to be recited at the same time. The water is poured thrice in form of a cross. The water is natural, holy oil, and chrism. Salt is put into the infant's mouth. Demons are exorcised by priest. Godparents promise help. Give a saint's name.

The infant should be baptized ASAP. They believe original sin guilt on it. Death sends dry infants to Limbo. Baptism sends infants to heaven. Pope Frank cancelled any Limbo. Anyone can baptize if necessary. Against parents if necessary.

Protestants and Reformers differ little from the RCC when it comes to baptism.

Most Protestants and Reformers:

Baptism saves. Infant baptism. No immersion.

Protestants and Reformers could not leave Mother Church and hated Baptists.

The premise that baptism saves is the causative error for many baptism heresies.

Think About Roman Catholics

They believe baptism does save.Infants have Adam's original sin.Infant mortality was very high.So they began baptizing infants.Mommies loved infant baptism.

Think About Roman Catholics

They believe baptism does save. Immersion was not convenient. Insufficient water was available. Sick persons could not be dipped. So they invented pouring water.

Think About Greek Catholics

They believe baptism does save. Infant mortality was very high. They must save all their infants. They know *baptizo* is immerse. So they immerse their infants!

Think About Church of Christ

They believe baptism does save. They know infants cannot believe. They deny age of accountability. So they reject any original sin!

Think About Mormons

They believe baptism does save. But it must be Mormon baptism. They reject infant baptism of RCC. So they invent baptism for dead!

Think About Arminian Baptists

They know baptism does not save. They know infants cannot believe. They are not sure about original sin. They invent age of accountability!

Peter, the RCC's first pope, destroyed their doctrine of baptism three ways at once. The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ: I Peter 3:21

- Baptism is a figure like the ark was a figure in only saves figuratively as a symbol.
- What is baptism a figure of? It is a symbol of resurrection by immersion in water.
- Baptism does not put away the filth of the flesh sins neither Adam's nor yours.
- Baptism is the answer of a good conscience which requires a conscious believer.

The RCC harlots corrupt this verse in modern versions to remove all three arguments.

Baptist baptism is Bible baptism – believers are immersed as a figure only.

Remember that the lie that baptism saves is the cause of most baptism heresies. Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. John 3:5

- This is one of the favorite verses corrupted to teach baptismal regeneration.
- There is no baptism in this verse because there is no literal water in the verse.
- The water here is a symbol of the *agent* of the Holy Ghost (compare John 7:38-39).
- By comparing Titus 3:5, the same combination is used for the *action* of washing.

God put other verses in the Bible to confound men that reject His offered truth. But these verses can be easily reconciled against Rome.

Felix Manz opposed the Reformer Ulrich Zwingli about infant baptism. He preached Bible baptism and would not stop, so the Zurich city council condemned him to drowning, January 5, 1527, his third baptism!





Anabaptist = Rebaptizer.


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Mother Church Teaches:

The precise terminology of the RCC:



The precise terminology of the RCC:


<u>Transubstantiation</u> turns the cracker to Jesus.





For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: <u>but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself</u>.

10 By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

11 And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:

If anyone denies that sacramental confession was instituted or is necessary to salvation, or says that confessing secretly to a priest alone (which the church has observed from the beginning) is alien from the command of Christ and a human invention,

If anyone says that God always remits the punishment with the guilt, and the satisfaction of penitents is the faith whereby they apprehend that Christ has satisfied for them,

If anyone says that the satisfaction by which penitents redeem their sins through Jesus Christ are not a worship of God but traditions of men which obscure the doctrine of grace, the true worship of God, and the benefit of the death of Christ,

The sacrament binding two Catholics in marriage. A Catholic wedding requires a Catholic priest. Outside the church is unmarried, adultery, etc. Outside the church is sin for excommunication. Sacramental marriage cannot be broken ever.

If anyone says that marriage is to be placed above virginity or celibacy and that it is not better and more blessed to remain in virginity or celibacy than to be united in matrimony,








HOLY ORDERS


- ONE OF THE TWO SACRAMENTS OF <u>SERVICE</u> (THE OTHER BEING MARRIAGE).
- SACRAMENTS OF SERVICE, BUILD UP THE PEOPLE OF GOD.
- THIS SACRAMENTS CONSECRATES BISHOPS, PRIESTS, AND DEACONS. THESE MEN ARE CALLED THE CLERGY, AND THROUGH THEM, JESUS GUIDES HIS CHURCH.






They have all taken the Sacrament of Holy Orders (they have been Ordained)











Mother Church Teaches:

To give men authority as bishops, priests, deacons. Gives the priests the power for Mass and Penance. Even Mary did not have miracle power of priests. RCC calls her priests *alter Christus* (another Christ). Her priests make the system work – tools of power.

Mother Church Teaches:

They take a vow of *celibacy* – they will not marry. They take vow of *obedience* – always obey bishop. They only take vow of *poverty* – if religious priest. Pope Paul VI ended the 1500-year tonsure in 1972. A priest acts *in persona Christi* as Christ and God. *Her priests are ordained in the line of Melchizedek.*

Paul warned about Satan working with the pope in all power, signs, lying wonders.

Paul listed New Testament offices several times, but never a mention of priests.

The only real priest is Jesus Christ, as the one mediator between God and men.

Psalm 110:4 about a priest forever after the order of Melchisedec is Jesus only.

Every believer is a royal priest but only through Jesus Christ as high priest.

A New Testament pastor, teacher, and elder is a Bible bishop, and no one else is.

Archbishops, cardinals, popes, and other invented offices are evil heresies.

The RCC title for priest is *Father,* directly opposing the rule of Jesus our Lord.

And <u>call no man your father upon the earth</u>: for one is your Father, which is in heaven.

Matthew 23:9

Do not corrupt this verse beyond its intent.

Your children should still call you father. Paul was Corinth's father in the gospel. Paul was Timothy's father in ministry. Abraham is the father of the faithful.

But a <u>public title</u> of spiritual superiority is wrong, which the RCC makes even worse up to popes. If anyone says that there is not in the New Testament a visible and external priesthood or there is not any power of consecrating and offering the true body and blood of the Lord and forgiving and retaining sins, but only an office and ministry of preaching the Gospel,

If anyone says that besides the priesthood, there are not in the Catholic Church other orders by which advance is made to the priesthood,

If anyone says that order (or ordination) is only a rite for choosing ministers of the word of God,

If anyone says that the sacred unction which the Church uses in holy ordination is not required but despised and pernicious (as are the other ceremonies of Order),

If anyone says that in the Catholic Church there is not a hierarchy by divine ordination consisting of bishops, priests, and ministers,

If anyone says that bishops are not superior to priests, or that they have not the power of confirming and ordaining, or that the power they possess is common to them and to priests,

If anyone says that bishops assumed by authority of the Roman Pontiff are not true bishops but a human figment,

A proof of Baptist perpetuity from the apostles is enemies naming heresies we believe. Do you love your Baptist fathers that despised the offices, hierarchy, and ordination of Rome and called them pernicious and a human figment?

Our Baptist fathers in the faith mocked the sacrament of Orders and died for it. I Corinthians 9:14


For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.


Ephesians 2:10
