THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

When the LORD says "Come thou and all thy house into the ark ..." (v 1), do those words suggest that the LORD Himself was there in the ark with Noah and his family? The LORD speaks through Isaiah, "When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee ... " (Isaiah 43:2). That whole chapter is filled with the LORD'S many assurances that He was doing a great work in the earth in taking care of Israel. He will take care of you in your emergency. Note how the Apostle in Hebrews 13:5 applied to New Testament saints some of the very words God spoke to Jacob when he fled from his brother, "I will never leave thee" (Genesis 28:15).

Are you living your life in full and total agreement with all of God's commands? Remember that the last verse of chapter six declares: "Thus did Noah: according to all that God commanded him, so did he." What a testimony God gave about Noah! Let each of us earn that testimony by living for and obeying the LORD likewise!
