THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

Moses voices an objection to God that Pharaoh will not hearken to him because he is “of uncircumcised lips” (vs 12, 30). Back in Sinai Moses claimed to be “slow of speech, and of a slow tongue” (4:10). The LORD answered that objection by reminding Moses that He had made his mouth and He would go with Moses' mouth and teach him what to say. The LORD'S answer should have settled the speech issue forever! Besides Moses had received the best professional training Egypt's royal family could offer. Surely Moses had passed Public Speaking 101 with honors, since he “was mighty in words and in deeds” (Acts 7:22). Excuses do not please our God!

What is the challenge you or I face today? Let us find the LORD'S answer (it may be His promises, commands or prohibitions), accept or claim it fully and set about to obey and please Him now.
