HELP:

1. In the last days (v 2).

2. They ask to be taught the LORD'S ways so they can walk in His paths, they do not learn war any more (vs 3-4).

3. Because they are replenished from the east, they are soothsayers, they please themselves in strangers, they are taken up with silver and gold, they are trusting in horses & chariots, the land is full of idols, they worship the work of their own hands (vs 6-9).

4. The proud and lofty (vs 11,12,17).

5. Into the holes of the rocks, caves of the earth, clefts of the rocks, tops of the rugged rocks (vs 19, 21).
