

## MATTHEW 8; July 28; Jesus Heals All Kinds of Sicknesses

### ANALYSIS:

### THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

The great tempest at sea looked very, very dangerous to the disciples, who cried out, "Lord, save us: we perish." How could Jesus sleep through such a storm? Why did He ask, "Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith?" Was it because He is really the Commander of all circumstances?!

What is your or my habitual response when a storm of life hits us? Let us immediately confess our wholehearted trust in our Lord's power, presence and preservation! "For He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee!" (Heb 13:5b).

### HELP:

1. Tell no man, show thyself to the priest, offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them (v 4).
2. This centurion believed Jesus had the power to heal his servant by speaking the word for healing, without even coming into his house (vs 8-10, 13).
3. Himself took our infirmities, and bore our sicknesses (v 17).
4. Foxes have holes, and birds have nests, but I cannot offer you even a place to sleep (vs 20-22).
5. We know you are the Son of God. What have we to do with thee? Art thou come to torment us before the time? Suffer us to go into the swine (vs 29-32).
