THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

When you enjoy warm sunshine, listen to the murmur or roar of a waterfalls or ocean waves on the beach, examine our solar system and the vast universe, do you pause to thank the LORD for revealing Himself to you as your Creator?

But God has revealed so much more about Himself as our Infinate Friend by words He chose - the words in our Bible! He is named: Immanuel, Shepherd, Father, Lamb of God, Jesus, Prince of the kings of the earth, Advocate, I AM, Redeemer, Savior and more. Do you read His words daily to know Him better?

Sin is a reality of life which can only be understood, faced and properly dealt with by believing the Bible. The question in verse 12, "Who can understand his errors?" alerts us to consider sin and its consequences. Let us learn from the Psalmist who confessed his sin and trusts God for cleansing. "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9). Protecting a "secret sin" risks committing "presumptuous" or deliberate sin which will control your or my life. Verse 14 is right for self examination as a necessary part of our daily walk with the Lord.
