Would to God ye could bear with me a little in my folly: and indeed bear with me. For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ.

II Corinthians 11:1-2

Church Purity Is a N.T. Doctrine

Paul was forced to folly of defending his motives and methods.

God gave the church like a bride to Jesus, to be a chaste virgin.

Paul feared false teachers, members, and doctrine that seduce.

Paul's obsessive loyalty was to Christ, not the church or any in it.

He, I, and then you are to be perfectly faithful as a wife to Jesus.

Anything that spoils or threatens the church's purity must be put away from us.

Anything that seduces or tempts you to flirt with heresy or the world must be stopped cold.

To grasp the lesson, God says any flirting with the world is spiritual adultery, and He does not hold back in His graphic description.

This study has also been called Church Due Process, and it was preached three years and three months ago for a discipline case.

A Chaste Virgin Is Our Goal to Jesus Christ

We cannot be today's average church; we go above and beyond.

• They flirt with heresy, worldly everything, sinners, and neglect.

Here is a summary of ecclesiology for pastors and pure churches.

How to manage a church and its discipline to be pure for Christ.

Many links at the end will make this overview rather complete.

I have taught all five spheres of authority, defining and defending fathers, husbands, employers, and civil rulers thoroughly.

An outline in summary format is available that has many more scriptures for each point.

Purity #1

Paul promised churches would have heresies (as at Corinth) to reveal God's true children committed to truth.

For there must be also heresies among you, that they which are approved may be made manifest among you.

I Corinthians 11:19

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Purity #2

Heresy or heretic are often misunderstood. They only mean false doctrine or practice. They do not mean a person is a reprobate.

But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain. A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject; Knowing that he that is such is subverted, and sinneth, being condemned of himself. Titus 3:9-11

4

Purity #3

Faithful churches pray for God to rid them of strange children, for hypocrites bring a curse like Achan did and restrict God's blessings.

Send thine hand from above;
rid me, and deliver me out of great waters,
from the hand of strange children;
Whose mouth speaketh vanity,
and their right hand is a right hand of falsehood.

Psalm 144:7-8

4

Purity #4

God killed N.T. church members for "minor" sins e.g. Ananias and Sapphira and many at Corinth, proving His severity against heretics.

I would they were even cut off which trouble you.

Galatians 5:12

4

Purity #5

Do not play with the church of God by neglect, rebellion, or mockery in fact or implied by your attitude or conduct.

Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are.

I Corinthians 3:16-17

4)

Purity #6

Most churches do not teach Bible examples and rules, so new converts or the simple may be confused, not knowing church doctrine.

These things write I unto thee,
hoping to come unto thee shortly:
But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how
thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God,
which is the church of the living God,
the pillar and ground of the truth.

I Timothy 3:14-15

4

Purity #7

An exclusion is never a surprise; the excluded are corrected, rebuked, and warned before it occurs; the church is given time to prepare.

This is the third time I am coming to you. In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established. I told you before, and foretell you, as if I were present, the second time; and being absent now I write to them which heretofore have sinned, and to all other, that, if I come again, I will not spare: Since ye seek a proof of Christ speaking in me, which to you-ward is not weak, but is mighty in you.

II Corinthians 13:1-3

Purity #8

Church exclusion is to save, if the sinners are erring elect, as Paul explained and taught it, which should guide our attitude and action.

In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when ye are gathered together, and my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ,

To deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

I Corinthians 5:4-5

Purity #9

We celebrate repentance more than most (or more than all) with fatted-calf feasts to match angels in heaven and Jesus' lessons. But the father said to his servants,
Bring forth the best robe, and put it on him;
and put a ring on his hand, and shoes on his feet:
And bring hither the fatted calf, and kill it;
and let us eat, and be merry:
For this my son was dead, and is alive again;
he was lost, and is found. And they began to be merry.

Luke 15:22-24

Purity #10

We discriminate against fools and scorners, as the Bible teaches and requires in both testaments, lest we be fools like them.

He that reproveth a scorner getteth to himself shame: and he that rebuketh a wicked man getteth himself a blot. Reprove not a scorner, lest he hate thee: rebuke a wise man, and he will love thee.

Proverbs 9:7-8

Purity #11

We pray for recovery of excluded brethren regularly, trusting God to save erring children and to save us from excluded reprobates.

If any man see his brother sin a sin which is not unto death, he shall ask, and he shall give him life for them that sin not unto death.

There is a sin unto death:

I do not say that he shall pray for it.

I John 5:16

Purity #12

You cannot improve discipline being gentler or harsher than scripture; the best hope of success is doing it His way without alteration.

All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

II Timothy 3:16-17

Purity #13

A pastor's greatest fear is weak members unable to discern ... grasp instructions ... rule emotions ... or honor God over persons.

But though we,
or an angel from heaven,
preach any other gospel unto you
than that which we have preached unto you,
let him be accursed.

Galatians 1:8

Purity #14

Every church has carnal members — belly worshippers by worldly minds — which Paul condemned as the enemies of Jesus Christ.

(For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.)

Philippians 3:18-19

Purity #15

Preaching pricks or cuts; it is death unto death or life unto life; it is used intentionally for those ends to expose saints and sinners.

For we are unto God a sweet savour of Christ, in them that are saved, and in them that perish:

To the one we are the savour of death unto death; and to the other the savour of life unto life.

And who is sufficient for these things?

II Corinthians 2:15-16

Purity #16

Jesus the perfect Pastor pricked and cut — He pricked His children for repentance and cut belly worshippers to expose their hypocrisy.

Then came his disciples, and said unto him,
Knowest thou that the Pharisees were offended,
after they heard this saying?
But he answered and said, Every plant,
which my heavenly Father hath not planted,
shall be rooted up.

Let them alone:

they be blind leaders of the blind.

And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch.

Matthew 15:12-14

Purity #17

The difference in response – pricked or cut – is not due to content or presentation but rather the heart condition of hearers.

Take heed therefore how ye hear: for whosoever hath, to him shall be given; and whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he seemeth to have.

Luke 8:18

4)

Purity #18

Faithful pastors dig and dung fruitless members, if they pose no threat to others; they let God cut them down in His own time.

Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard,
Behold, these three years I come seeking fruit on this fig tree,
and find none: cut it down; why cumbereth it the ground?
And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone
this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung it:
And if it bear fruit, well: and if not,
then after that thou shalt cut it down.

Luke 13:7-9

Purity #19

Faithful pastors quickly drive wolves out. If a foolish or fruitless member is respected, he will be removed quickly to protect the flock.

I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not. Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth them out of the church.

III John 1:9-10

4)

Purity #20

Faithful pastors dig and dung wheat and tares, trusting Jesus' doctrine to His apostles that they will be exposed on Judgment Day.

The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one; The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels. As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world.

Matthew 13:38-40

Purity #21

Pastors must be friends and foes; they must war against members' thoughts and ideas, and they also give nursing care and comfort.

For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

II Corinthians 10:3-6

Purity #22

Pastors may use public rebukes short of exclusion. They are authorized, illustrated, and encouraged for the sinners and others.

Them that sin rebuke before all, that others also may fear.

I Timothy 5:20

I beseech Euodias, and beseech Syntyche, that they be of the same mind in the Lord.

Philippians 4:2

Smite a scorner, and the simple will beware: and reprove one that hath understanding, and he will understand knowledge.

Proverbs 19:25

4)

Purity #23

Pastors love mercy like Jesus their Master, so they will show it short of sinful compromise to cover a multitude of private sins. But if ye had known what this meaneth,
I will have mercy, and not sacrifice,
ye would not have condemned the guiltless.

Matthew 12:7

It is reported commonly
that there is fornication among you,
and such fornication as is not so much as named
among the Gentiles, that one should have his father's wife.

I Corinthians 5:1

Purity #24

Jesus promised to divide families as a test and cost of true disciples, which must be remembered and honored over family ties. Think not that I am come to send peace on earth:
I came not to send peace, but a sword....
And a man's foes shall be they of his own household.
He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.

Matthew 10:34-37

Purity #25

God may ask for your Isaac. Will you, like faithful Abraham, zealously execute the sacrifice for God's house, truth, and worship.

And it came to pass after these things, that God did tempt Abraham, and said unto him, Abraham: and he said, Behold, here I am. And he said, Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of. And Abraham rose up early in the morning....

Genesis 22:1-3

4)

Purity #26

God wisely measures zeal for Him and truth by family and friends, and He expects you to be the first to execute judgment on heretics.

If thy brother, the son of thy mother, or thy son, or thy daughter, or the wife of thy bosom, or thy friend, which is as thine own soul, entice thee secretly, saying, Let us go and serve other gods.... Thou shalt not consent unto him, nor hearken unto him; neither shall thine eye pity him, neither shalt thou spare, neither shalt thou conceal him: But thou shalt surely kill him; thine hand shall be first upon him to put him to death, and afterwards the hand of all the people.

Deuteronomy 13:6-11

Purity #27

Moses promised God's blessing on sons of Levi that would consecrate themselves to the LORD by killing family and friends for the calf.

Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD'S side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him. And he said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, and go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp, and slay every man his brother, and every man his companion, and every man his neighbour.

Exodus 32:26-29

Purity #28

God gave Phinehas and his family a huge reward for zealously using a javelin instead of crying with the church's weak compromisers.

And when Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, saw it, he rose up from among the congregation, and took a javelin in his hand; And he went after the man of Israel into the tent, and thrust both of them through, the man of Israel, and the woman through her belly. So the plague was stayed from the children of Israel.

Numbers 25:7-8

Purity #29

A person with faith may appear calloused at such times, for they have God and persons in their proper places, like David and Job.

In whose eyes a vile person is contemned; but he honoureth them that fear the LORD.

Psalm 15:4

I will early destroy all the wicked of the land; that I may cut off all wicked doers from the city of the LORD.

Psalm 101:8

Purity #30

God will replace family 100-fold lost in the line of duty for loving and obeying Him over relationships of family and friends or assets.

And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's, But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life.

Mark 10:29-30

Purity #31

You must believe God over and against feelings to obey for a blessing; sentimentality will cause compromise and cost you greatly.

Thine eye shall not pity him, but thou shalt put away the guilt of innocent blood from Israel, that it may go well with thee.

Deuteronomy 19:13

Chasten thy son while there is hope, and let not thy soul spare for his crying.

Proverbs 19:18

The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame.

Proverbs 29:15

Purity #32

Separation from heretics is a N.T. rule for both churches and pastors taught repeatedly.

Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them.

For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.

Romans 16:17-18

Purity #33

Separation improves church quality like little else, because faithful churches replace belly worshippers with fervent believers from God.

Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

Acts 2:47

Purity #34

Pruning removes fruitless members — bad examples and unhappy souls; growth occurs; worship improves; prayers are enhanced.

But the children of Israel committed a trespass in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel.

Joshua 7:1

Purity #35

Pastors must make diligent inquisition and determine facts of each case and never rush to judgment foolishly lest good souls be hurt.

If thou shalt hear say in one of thy cities, which the LORD thy God hath given thee to dwell there ... Then shalt thou enquire, and make search, and ask diligently; and, behold, if it be truth, and the thing certain, that such abomination is wrought among you; Thou shalt surely smite the inhabitants of that city with the edge of the sword, destroying it utterly, and all that is therein, and the cattle thereof, with the edge of the sword.

Deuteronomy 13:12-18

4)

Purity #36

Pastors, like fathers, are to be followed in applying scripture or ruling due to their office, purpose of life, and church covenant.

Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation.

Hebrews 13:7

Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.

Hebrews 13:17

4)

Purity #37

The Bible allows considerable pastoral and church liberty in many things, as long as the content and orderliness of worship is kept.

How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation.

Let all things be done unto edifying.

I Corinthians 14:26

Purity #38

Pastors must rule in subjective areas or controversies where scripture may appear to contradict to rightly judge holy and profane.

And they shall teach my people the difference between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean. And in controversy they shall stand in judgment; and they shall judge it according to my judgments: and they shall keep my laws and my statutes in all mine assemblies; and they shall hallow my sabbaths.

Ezekiel 44:23-24

Purity #39

Offenders against pastors will pay for their presumption, for God views such arrogance and insubordination as rebellion against Him.

And Moses said, This shall be,
when the LORD shall give you in the evening flesh to eat,
and in the morning bread to the full;
for that the LORD heareth your murmurings
which ye murmur against him: and what are we?
your murmurings are not against us,
but against the LORD.

Exodus 16:8

And the LORD said unto Samuel,
Hearken unto the voice of the people
in all that they say unto thee:
for they have not rejected thee,
but they have rejected me,
that I should not reign over them.

I Samuel 8:7

These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority.

Let no man despise thee.

Titus 2:15

4)

Purity #40

God's judgment confirms – Miriam and Uzziah got leprosy; Korah and all were buried alive; 42 children were torn by she bears; etc.

And Moses said, Hereby ye shall know that the LORD hath sent me to do all these works; for I have not done them of mine own mind. If these men die the common death of all men, or if they be visited after the visitation of all men; then the LORD hath not sent me. But if the LORD make a new thing, and the earth open her mouth, and swallow them up, with all that appertain unto them, and they go down quick into the pit; then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the LORD.

Numbers 16:28-30

Purity #41

Pastors can make errors for sure; they should be respectfully questioned before rejection, but this is a small issue in rebellious times.

Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses.

I Timothy 5:19

Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God. Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful. But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged of you, or of man's judgment: yea, I judge not mine own self. For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but he that judgeth me is the Lord.

I Corinthians 4:1-5

Purity #42

Churches should review and recommit to their church covenant when they receive new members, so none can claim ignorance or excuse themselves from their duties later. Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

I Corinthians 1:10

Be of the same mind one toward another.

Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate.

Be not wise in your own conceits.

Romans 12:16



Purity #43

Pastors should present the least amount of public sins necessary to satisfy consciences with certain facts, for protecting reputations, and for simpler future restoration.

Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

Ephesians 4:31-32

And of some have compassion, making a difference: And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

Jude 1:22-23

Purity #44

Pastors may prudently end communication with rebels after they are identified to protect the flock and manage smooth discipline by enough existing evidence.

Cutting Off Communication with Rebels

- He measures the profit versus the risk whether any hope of gain.
- Efforts after the fact are lame, hypocritical, and can be offensive.
- Paul did not tell the Corinthians to do any such thing (I Cor 5:1-7,13).
- More opinions by uninformed witnesses can create confusion.
- Members will never be asked to exclude without sufficient proof.
- The sinners may be scorners, forfeiting rebuke (Pr 9:7-8; Matt 7:6).
- Public sinners do not need coddling, or feel needed, but shamed.
- Provoking enemies or scorners leads to unnecessary charges.
- You may expose yourself foolishly to a devilish spirit (I Cor 15:33).
- Members' opinions are irrelevant. Churches are monarchies.

Purity #45

Scorners before and after exclusion are treated differently – they are rejected by wise men for twisting truth and hurting men.

Cast out the scorner, and contention shall go out; yea, strife and reproach shall cease.

Proverbs 22:10

Proud and haughty scorner is his name, who dealeth in proud wrath.

Proverbs 21:24

Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you.

Matthew 7:6

4)

Purity #46

Fools before and after exclusion are treated differently – they are slighted and ignored for stupidity, since correction will not succeed.

Speak not in the ears of a fool: for he will despise the wisdom of thy words.

Proverbs 23:9

Though thou shouldest bray a fool in a mortar among wheat with a pestle, yet will not his foolishness depart from him.

Proverbs 27:22

4)

Purity #47

Different treatment for character or conduct comforts the godly, warns the simple, ignores scorners. Humble get love and effort.

A reproof entereth more into a wise man than an hundred stripes into a fool.

Proverbs 17:10

Purity #48

We do not immediately embrace the penitent. They need fruits of repentance like others; words are cheap. The fornicator at Corinth had suffered for some time.

But when he saw many of the
Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism,
he said unto them, O generation of vipers,
who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?
Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:

Matthew 3:7-8

Purity #49

Before excluded members, where clear shunning is commanded, what does a Christian have in common with unbelievers?

Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

Amos 3:3

Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

I Corinthians 15:33

Purity #50

Christians must examine themselves for any sins to prove they are not reprobates, lest they be hypocrites in judging others.

Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

Matthew 7:5

Purity #51

Authority is God's ordinance like baptism or charity – all five spheres – so any balking, criticizing, or rebelling is against God Himself.

Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers.

For there is no power but of God:

the powers that be are ordained of God.

Whosoever therefore resisteth the power,

resisteth the ordinance of God: and they

that resist shall receive to themselves damnation.

Romans 13:1-2

Purity #52

Bitterness (unresolved offences or grudges) is great evil, flunks God's grace, and will grow, trouble a church, and defile many.

Looking diligently
lest any man fail of the grace of God;
lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you,
and thereby many be defiled;

Hebrews 12:15

Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.

Leviticus 19:18

Purity #53

Criticism of church or pastor sows discord and violates church unity, and God hates all that do so and those that listen to them.

These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him ... he that soweth discord among brethren.

Proverbs 6:16-19

A wicked doer giveth heed to false lips; and a liar giveth ear to a naughty tongue.

Proverbs 17:4

The north wind driveth away rain: so doth an angry countenance a backbiting tongue.

Proverbs 25:23

Purity #54

Pride and self-righteousness lead to haughty, negative spirits that find fault with everyone and everything and will not listen to reproof.

Only by pride cometh contention: but with the well advised is wisdom.

Proverbs 13:10

Seest thou a man wise in his own conceit? there is more hope of a fool than of him.

Proverbs 26:12

4)

Purity #55

Rebuking members verbally or by angry faces is necessary for church preservation and prosperity by apostolic order from Paul.

Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men.

I Thessalonians 5:14

4

Purity #56

Leaven must be kept out of the church, by vigilance of pastor and people, which can be false doctrine and/or public sinners.

Your glorying is not good.

Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump?

Purge out therefore the old leaven,

that ye may be a new lump,

as ye are unleavened.

For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us: Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

I Corinthians 5:6-8

4

Purity #57

Passive rebellion is children avoiding parents or members not loving or engaging with church services, members, or preaching.

A servant will not be corrected by words: for though he understand he will not answer.

Proverbs 29:19

4

Purity #58

Quitting does not work. Not attending is forsaking the assemblies and breaking your covenant. Spouses cannot walk out after vows or soldiers go AWOL after swearing-in.

Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)
And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

Gene examination means you may repeat faults of parents, as the nature, example, ideas, and priorities are given to children.

Cold is better than lukewarm in some ways, as Jesus taught, but lukewarm souls should repent, not turn cold in arrogant rebellion.

Purity #62

Hate hypocrisy, especially in exclusions, but imperfect judgment, like imperfect authority, is better than no judgment or no authority. Then spake Jesus to the multitude,

that observe and do; but do not ye after their works:

Pastors must be like serpents and doves among the wolves of today's compromising, effeminate Christians.

Repentance for membership or restoration must be godly repentance as defined in the Bible and not just worldly sorrow.

Members must be observant; there are few surprises in church discipline; rebels have already exposed themselves to the attentive.

Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.... But let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another. For every man shall bear his own burden.

Purity #72

Love is the greatest grace by many measures, including evidence of eternal life and a new heart, so it will be obvious by fervent actions.

A new commandment I give unto you,

That ye love one another;
as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.

By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples,

if ye have love one to another.

John 13:34-35

Purity #73

Fruit is what our Lord taught as the criterion to judge preachers, and it applies as well to ordinary members by character and conduct.

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

Purity #74

There is a process to follow for grievances between members, and ignoring the process indicates hatred and rebellion against God.

Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee;

Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.

Matthew 5:23-24

Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother. But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established. And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell it unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican.

Purity #75

The distinction between sins against God and sins against men is huge; it is dealt with by Paul in two successive, separate chapters.

If one man sin against another,
the judge shall judge him:
but if a man sin against the LORD,
who shall intreat for him?

of their father, because the LORD would slay them.

It is reported commonly
that there is fornication among you,

Some sins/sinners should not be prayed for, which is hard for the Biblically illiterate or the emotionally sentimental to grasp and obey.

Do not play with discipline or communion for church purity due to severe consequences.
