God's great ones that went above and beyond.

Let us repeat the verses that describe Paul's obsession to do more than duty and us as well.

Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended:
but this one thing I do, forgetting those things
which are behind, and reaching forth unto
those things which are before,
I press toward the mark for
the prize of the high calling
of God in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 3:13-14

But as touching brotherly love
ye need not that I write unto you:
for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another.
And indeed ye do it toward all the brethren which are in all
Macedonia: but we beseech you, brethren,
that ye increase more and more;

I Thessalonians 4:9-10

Now God himself and our Father, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way unto you. And the Lord make you to increase and abound in love one toward another, and toward all men, even as we do toward you: To the end he may stablish your hearts unblameable in holiness before God, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his saints.

I Thessalonians 3:11-13

Our Paul pressed the churches to do more and more.

The goal is to be solidly ready to meet God and His Son.

One purpose is to define and then motivate to greatness.

Another purpose is to embrace creative church practices.

We should be obsessed to fear, love, serve, and worship God with the bold zeal of great ones.

He and His Son have done far more than duty or fairness toward us. We owe all in return.

The greatest fulfillment and joy in life is to bring gifts to God of loving worship past duty.

We will never go beyond our liberty in Christ, but neither let us ever come short of pressing it.

In the simplest way possible, let us identify some great ones and what they did more than duty. And like unto him was there no king before him, that turned to the LORD with all his heart, and with all his soul, and with all his might, according to all the law of Moses; neither after him arose there any like him.

II Kings 23:25

God has always ranked men, and to be great in His sight is easy, just be extreme for Him.

DAVID and Goliath

Instantly convicted to shut the blasphemer's mouth!

He did not care all others were afraid or what they thought.

He did not care that Eliab and Saul both tried to discourage him.

He ran to meet the proud giant with five stones for his whole family.


To David it was the cause of God ... and he gave all the glory to Jehovah.

King Saul and tradition of 40 years had left it in storage.

He turned the event into a massive celebration for the LORD.

He danced with all his might without regard for his own dignity.

He punished the foolish woman left over from Saul's profane family.

Profane souls will always oppose worship.

Are you like David wanting to celebrate God?

Is our church doing all it can to glorify our Lord?

DAVID and the Temple

God never asked for one or hinted for one!

David instantly thought of it as soon as he was free.

He had to make sure God was treated better than he was.

When he could not build it, he made sure he paid and prepared.

After much preparation, he charged Solomon and princes to grandeur.

God never asked for it or hinted for it. Get it?

David thought way beyond Moses' tent. Get it?

Why did David think outside the box constantly?

How much did God like David going beyond Moses?

He built David a house and his Son Jesus reigns forever!



DAVID and Music

The Psalms are lyrics of songs for worship!

God and His Son Jesus want them sung in the N.T.

David invented numerous instruments to exalt worship.

He organized orchestras and singers for constant glory to God.

Hezekiah 200 years later and Josiah 300 years later still used them.


If you do not like to sing to worship. What?

Phinehas and Baalpeor

Balaam taught Moab to fornicate with Israel.

God sent a plague to punish the fornicating church.

While the nation cried, Phinehas speared a coupled couple.

Did God approve? God stopped the plague and blessed Phinehas.

God made Phinehas an example of justification like Abraham and Rahab.

Then stood up Phinehas,
and executed judgment:
and so the plague was stayed.

And that was counted unto him for righteousness
unto all generations for evermore.

Psalm 106:30-31

Who do you cry for? Only crying for God counts!

What takes over a man to be so violent to others?

Phinehas is one of the most blessed men in the Bible.

It was his zeal that God praised and blessed this man for.

Hannah and Samuel

This zealous woman gave her son to the LORD.

She trained him so well that he worshipped about 5.

Hezekiah and Passover

He cleaned up the temple as soon as king!

He broke the law keeping the feast a month late.

He broke the law with participants not rightly sanctified.

He broke the law by celebrating it for two weeks, not just one.

Did God like his creativity? Their prayers came up into His dwelling place!

Hezekiah had prophets, but he also prayed.

To cover ... "The good LORD pardon every one."

Do you love him for his zeal? One of God's greats!

He did not care about habit, tradition, or even the law.

God will have mercy over sacrifice and worship over it also!

We will never go beyond our liberty in Christ, but neither let us ever come short of pressing it.

Jehu and Baal Worship

God chose a man that drove furiously!

He killed kings and sons of Judah and Israel.

He killed Jezebel and trampled her under his horse.

He deceived Israel for a fabulous killing of Baal worshippers.

God's words of praise are some of the best, but he returned to the calves.

And the LORD said unto Jehu,

Because thou hast done well

in executing that which is right in mine eyes,
and hast done unto the house of Ahab according

to all that was in mine heart,
thy children of the fourth generation
shall sit on the throne of Israel.

II Kings 10:30

JONADAB and Houses/Wine

He was Jehu's partner but did not backslide!

He denied his family right to houses and to wine.

He did this in prophetic warning of coming judgment.

They kept their father's extreme rule for several generations.

They would not compromise even with Jeremiah serving (chap 35)!

ISRAEL and **Preaching Service**

They went and got Ezra to preach to them.

They stood from morning to noon to hear preaching.

The reverently lifted hands and bowed heads, AMEN, AMEN.

They wept with conviction; they had great mirth; they asked for more.

When they learned about the feast of booths, they did it seven days gladly.

MARY of Bethany

Jesus loved Lazarus, Martha, and Mary.

Mary on one occasion sat at His feet to hear.

Mary also anointed Jesus very costly and personally.

She was criticized by Martha and Judas, but Jesus defended.

Who are you most like? ... Mary? ... Judas? ... Martha? ... Lazarus?

What made Mary sit at His feet and ignore Martha?

What made Mary so extreme to not just sit quietly?

Was it not a bad waste for so much costly ointment?

Wasn't she a little extreme and forward with her hair?

Jesus loved her and promised it would be told worldwide!

MARY Magdalene and the Tomb

She constantly followed Jesus.

She rose while dark to anoint His body again.

When she could not find it, she ran to tell the apostles.

When they could not find Him, she peeked and wept further.

Jesus appeared first to this zealous woman after His resurrection.

PAUL and his Calling

How many minutes to convert Saul to Jesus?

What did he do after getting his sight and a bite?

He labored more abundantly than all the other apostles.

He fought a good fight. He finished His course. He kept the faith.

He was never content. He never rested on his laurels. He pressed on.

He told us to follow him as he followed Christ.

Why did Paul not have a wife? Come on already!
