and in favour with God and man.

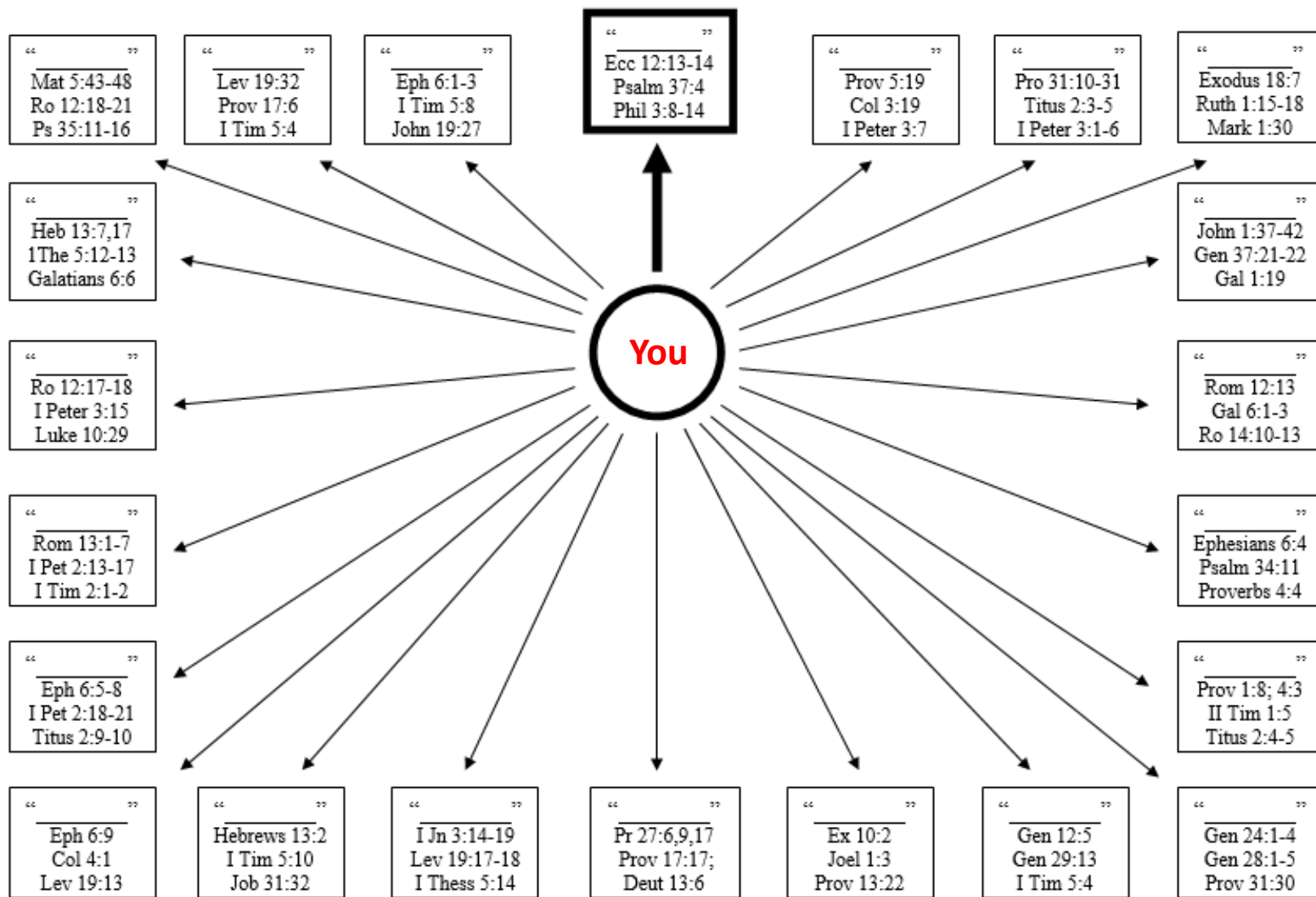
