Jesus Is Lord

when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

God,

who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,

Hebrews 1:1

God ... the best word to start ... is our Jehovah.

Sundry = Divers = different/various = times and ways to prophets.

Our God revealed Himself so that all ... but especially we ... may know Him.

Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

Hebrews 1:2

We have the best – His Son – like Sermon on the Mount.

In God's great drama, He planned for Jesus to rule the universe.

Jesus also created all things – nothing made without Him – He is Lord of all.

Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, Hebrews 1:3a

If you want to see God's glory - learn about Jesus.

No man has seen God – He is invisible – Jesus is His image to us.

The universe is held together by the mighty order of its Creator, Jesus.

when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Our Lord Jesus is also our Savior and Deliverer.

Jesus is by Himself the only Savior from sin – the Second Adam.

He finished a legal payment to save you. Our lawyer sits at God's right hand.

When did Jesus purge our sins? At the cross and after!

Only then was He exalted to God's right hand and could sit down.

He made the legal payment for our sins ... He then began intercession for us.

Who is this "he" that by himself purged our sins?

It is the Son of God that by verse 2 spoke for God to the Hebrews.

This is no average person – but rather the most glorious one in the universe.

What Has the Context Told Us?

Brightness of God's Glory
Express Image of God's Person
Upholds the Universe By His Power

This glorious Person was falsely accused ... then tortured ... then painfully murdered for your sins.

Does the Bible Say Similar Things Elsewhere?

And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us,

(and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the

only begotten of the Father,)

full of grace and truth.

No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

When should we interpret "had" for what follows?

Jesus died, rose, ascended, and took His throne 2000 years ago.

Purging our sins and being crowned was past to Paul in the first century.

Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

Hebrews 9:12

Who <u>hath delivered</u> us from the power of darkness, and <u>hath translated</u> us into the kingdom of his dear Son:

In whom we <u>have redemption</u> through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

Colossians 1:13-14

God does not <u>offer</u> eternal life to any through His Son – He <u>gives</u> eternal life to those He <u>gave</u> to Jesus and <u>gave</u> His Son to save.

These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee:

As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him.

John 17:1-2

Jesus did offer Himself ... but not to sinners ... rather to God.

How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Hebrews 9:14 (see also 7:27 and Eph 5:2)

His offering was accepted ... not by depraved, dead sinners ... but rather by God for elect sinners.

Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.

Ephesians 1:5-6

Then Peter opened his mouth, and said,
Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons:
But in every nation he that feareth him,
and worketh righteousness,
is accepted with him.

Acts 10:34-35 (see also II Cor 5:9)

when he had **by himself** purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Purge = clean, cleanse, clear, purify, remove.

Jesus washed away our sins from God's sight by His blood.

Purging sins is no whitewash or Band-Aid but getting totally rid of them.

But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son <u>cleanseth us</u> from all sin.

I John 1:7

And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin.

I John 3:5

Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Revelation 1:5-6

And their sins and iniquities
will I remember no more.

Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.

Hebrews 10:17-18 (See also Hebrews 8:12)

The bloody sacrifices of the Old Testament, from skins in Eden to Moses' offerings, and including our own Lord's Supper, repeat blood as the purgative.

And almost all things are by the law <u>purged with blood</u>; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

Hebrews 9:22

Baptism does not wash away sins, as the followers of Alexander Campbell think, when they refuse to rightly divide the perfect word of truth.

The like figure
whereunto even baptism doth also now save us
(not the putting away of the filth of the flesh,
but the answer of a good conscience toward God,)
by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

Because baptismal regeneration from the Mother Church makes it hard for her daughters to reject her many abominations.

Old Testament sacrifices of blood could never purge the conscience from sin guilt, but the gospel of Jesus does, so baptism is a clean conscience.

Which was a figure for the time then present, in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience;

Hebrews 9:9 (see also Hebrews 10:1-4)

How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Hebrews 9:14

Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled <u>from an evil conscience</u>, and our bodies washed with pure water.

Hebrews 10:22

But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

II Peter 1:9

when he had by himself purged <u>our sins</u>, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high; Hebrews 1:3b

Not all sins ... but our sins ... His elect.

Not some sins ... but all our sins ... one sin could damn us to hell.

Not only are all our sins purged away ... but also replaced by righteousness.

And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

Matthew 1:21

But he was wounded for <u>our transgressions</u>, he was bruised for <u>our iniquities</u>: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the <u>transgression</u> of my people was he stricken.

Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him;
he hath put him to grief:
when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin,
he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days,
and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.

Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

| Saiah 53:12

For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

II Corinthians 5:21

Forget this nonsense:

Sufficient for all men; efficient for the elect only.

Rather ... planned, designed, intended, and applied specifically for the elect without any regard to the rest.

He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

Romans 8:32-34

We ruined everything in Eden with our sins, and we continue to ruin everything every time we sin, but He purged all our sins!

We are here today to celebrate our sins being purged by the death of Jesus the Son of God and to go from here to live totally for Him.

Never, friend, never should you put any stock in hearing or even saying these things about His shed blood.

You must obey Him to know.

No man ... gets to sit until the job is done.

His seat is not temporary ... it is the throne of David and God.

Our great King of kings is seated on His throne with victorious dominion.

He is not moving or traveling ... He is set down beside the LORD Jehovah, and He will intercede for you now and later.

Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum:

We have such an high priest,

who is set on the right hand of

the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;

A minister of the sanctuary,

and of the true tabernacle,

which the Lord pitched, and not man.

But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.

Hebrews 10:12-13

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, <u>and is set down</u> at the right hand of the throne of God.

Hebrews 12:2

And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne.

Revelation 12:5

And I saw a great white throne,

and him that sat on it,

from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away;

and there was found no place for them.

Revelation 20:11

Your faith in Jesus the Son of God can overcome the world by believing on this glorious King of kings, for you can be in His throne with Him.

To him that overcometh
will I grant to sit with me in my throne,

Mark 16:19

Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

Acts 2:33

Who is he that condemneth?

It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

Romans 8:34

And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

Eph 1:19-21

If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.

Colossians 3:1

Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

I Peter 3:22

Are There More? Yes, Yes, Yes!

But let this unusual terminology excite your soul for God's power in Jesus!

The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree. Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. And we are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him.

Acts 5:30-32

When Caiaphas swore Jesus to tell the truth when on trial for His life, what sweet words did Jesus have for them?

But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God. Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

Matthew 26:63-64

We take great delight in such authority and warnings from our Lord, but His position at God's right hand is perfect for our Priest!

Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

Hebrews 4:14-16

when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Hebrews 1:3b

Majesty = dignity or greatness of a sovereign.

The Holy Spirit only here in Hebrews calls God ... MAJESTY.

Our LORD Jehovah is so sovereignly great ... He is Majesty personified!

Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum:

We have such an high priest,

who is set on the right hand of the

throne of the Majesty in the heavens;

Hebrews 8:1

A simple review of the 25 occurrences of "majesty" in the Old Testament is glorious!

Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all.

I Chronicles 29:11

Hast thou an arm like God?
or canst thou thunder with a voice like him?

Deck thyself now with majesty and excellency;
and array thyself with glory and beauty.

Cast abroad the rage of thy wrath:
and behold every one that is proud,
and abase him.

Job 40:9-11

The LORD reigneth,

he is clothed with majesty;

the LORD is clothed with strength,
wherewith he hath girded himself:
the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved.

Psalm 93:1

Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself.

For if the word spoken by angels was stedfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just recompence of reward; How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him;

Jesus Christ Is the Great Person and Purpose of Life for You to Delight In

What should you do today? ... Believe He is.

What else must you do? ... Obey Him fully.

What does He want today? ... Communion.
