Two Names / Titles of Jesus
Son of God & Lord of All

Jesus = Personal Name

Jesus = Jehoshua or Joshua

Jesus = Jehovah is Salvation

And she shall bring forth a son,
and thou shalt call his name **JESUS**:
for he shall save his people from their sins.

Matthew 1:21

Christ = Messiah (Anointed)

He first findeth his own brother Simon,
and saith unto him, We have found the Messias,
which is, being interpreted, the Christ.

John 1:41

Personal Name + Messiah Title =

Jesus the Christ

Which Merged into a Fuller Name

Then charged he his disciples
that they should tell no man
that he was Jesus the Christ.

Matthew 16:20

The book of the generation of Jesus Christ,
the son of David, the son of Abraham.

Matthew 1:1

Jesus of Nazareth =

Unique Identifier of Common Name
by the City Where Jesus Grew Up

And he came and dwelt in a city called Nazareth:
that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophets,
He shall be called a Nazarene.

Matthew 2:23

With that Introduction to Jesus Christ,
Let Us See Two New Names/Titles

Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

But made himself of no reputation,

and took upon him the form of a servant,

and was made in the likeness of men:

And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Philippians 2:5-8

Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him,
and given him a name which is above every name:
That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in
heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;
And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ
is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Philippians 2:9-11

JESUS Is ... the Son of God

Let us rejoice in this glorious name God gave Him when He ascended up into heaven to sit beside Almighty God.

Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.
I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me,
Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee.

Psalm 2:6-7

When did this event occur?

When Jesus rose from the dead and God formally declared Him His Son, after He had defeated the rulers against Him.

God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children,
in that he hath raised up Jesus again;
as it is also written in the second psalm,
Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee.

Acts 13:33

When did this event occur?

Though we are tempted to think of His birth, this name was His inheritance from God over all the angels.

Being made so much better than the angels,
as he hath by inheritance obtained a
more excellent name than they.

For unto which of the angels said he at any time,
Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee?

And again, I will be to him a Father,
and he shall be to me a Son?

Hebrews 1:4-5

How Important Is This Name?

Hopefully you can see it from Psalm 2 into Paul's preaching in Acts 13 and then very important in Hebrews 1.

And Simon Peter answered and said,
Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.
And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou,
Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it
unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.
And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter,
and upon this rock I will build my church;
and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

Matthew 16:16-18

Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away?
Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go?
thou hast the words of eternal life.

And we believe and are sure
that thou art that Christ,
the Son of the living God.

John 6:67-69

And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence
of his disciples, which are not written in this book:
But these are written, that ye might believe
that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God;
and that believing ye might have life through his name.

John 20:30-31

And as they went on their way, they came unto a certain water:
and the eunuch said, See, here is water;
what doth hinder me to be baptized?

And Philip said, If thou believest
with all thine heart, thou mayest.

And he answered and said,
I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

Acts 8:36-37

For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world:
and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.

Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that
believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

It Is an Incredible Thing!

The LORD God Jehovah, an infinite Spirit,
has a human Son like us to be the
Firstborn in the family of God!

For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

Colossians 2:9

Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him,
and given him a name which is above every name:
That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in
heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;
And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ
is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

JESUS Is ... Lord of All

Let us rejoice in this glorious title God gave
Him for every tongue to confess to
the glory of God the Father.

Lord = Master or Ruler

Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.
If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet;
ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

John 13:13-14

But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah,
though thou be little among the thousands of Judah,
yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in
Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

Micah 5:2

Jesus is so much a Lord that He
is also called, Lord of lords!
(Master of masters)
(Ruler of rulers)

These shall make war with the Lamb,
and the Lamb shall overcome them:
for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings:
and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful.

Revelation 17:14

And he hath on his vesture
and on his thigh a name written,
KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

Revelation 19:16

Enjoy and love these verses that introduce and emphasize Jesus as Lord (to the glory of God).

The LORD said unto my Lord,
Sit thou at my right hand, until
I make thine enemies thy footstool.

Psalm 110:1

For David is not ascended into the heavens:
but he saith himself, The LORD said unto my Lord,
Sit thou on my right hand, Until I make thy foes thy footstool.
Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly,
that God hath made that same Jesus,
whom ye have crucified,
both Lord and Christ.

Acts 2:34-36

The response to this scriptural warning about Jesus as Lord should be our response.

Now when they heard this,
they were pricked in their heart,
and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles,
Men and brethren, what shall we do?

Acts 2:37

When Peter began preaching to
Cornelius, he called Jesus
Lord of all!

The word which God sent unto the children of Israel,
preaching peace by Jesus Christ: (he is Lord of all:)

That word, I say, ye know, which was published
throughout all Judaea, and began from Galilee,
after the baptism which John preached;

Acts 10:36-37

To say that Jesus is the Lord, and
mean it sincerely, is a gift
of the Holy Ghost!

Wherefore I give you to understand,
that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed:
and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord,
but by the Holy Ghost.

I Corinthians 12:3

How can you know if you truly
believe Jesus is the Lord?

And why call ye me, Lord, Lord,
and do not the things which I say?

Luke 6:46

And he said, Who art thou, Lord?
And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest:
it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.
And he trembling and astonished said,
Lord, what wilt thou have me to do?

Acts 9:5-6

Our God and His Son Are Unique
and Separate from All
Other Religions

For though there be that are called gods,
whether in heaven or in earth,
(as there be gods many, and lords many,)
But to us there is but one God, the Father,
of whom are all things, and we in him;
and one Lord Jesus Christ,
by whom are all things,
and we by him.

I Corinthians 8:5-6

There is one body, and one Spirit,
even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;
One Lord, one faith, one baptism,
One God and Father of all,
who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

Jeremiah 23:5-6

Every part of our lives should be lived as unto the Lord Jesus Christ.

For whether we live, we live unto the Lord;
and whether we die, we die unto the Lord:
whether we live therefore, or die, we are the Lord's.
For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived,
that he might be Lord both of the dead and living.

We can die as did two examples
calling upon the name of the Lord.

And he said unto Jesus,
Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom.
And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee,
