What Will You Do for Your Church?

- Will you pray for it ... with all prayer, supplication, and watching?
- Will you <u>prepare</u> for its assemblies ... to honor God like a governor?
- Will you <u>participate</u> in assemblies ... to help congregational worship?
- Will you <u>protect</u> its doctrine, practice, peace, unity, and communion?
- Will you provide for it every way you are able with effort, time, money?
- Will you <u>promote</u> it passionately as others do things far inferior to it?

- Spiritual conversation of Christ.







They Understand their Commitment

- Membership in most churches is weakened to nothing.
- Attendance does not make members, or churches great.
- Like marriage, it is a commitment to Christ and His body.
- Leaving must be done God's way or it is unacceptable.
- Are you a great member? Let us live and die in the Lord.

Baptism Is Not Membership

- 1. In fact, they are not even related except order.
- 2. Baptism is the first act of obedience to the Lord.
- 3. It is an individual event between a man and God.
- 4. It is the answer of a good conscience by salvation.
- 5. Church membership is a congregational event.
- 6. A man and church choose to relate by N.T. rules.
- 7. Membership is formal as Paul saw at Jerusalem.
- 8. One is either in or out of a church by its action.

They Walk with God and Delight in Him

- Their relationship with God is far greater than religion.
- They are spiritually minded and put earthly things last.
- They keep personal devotions for intimate fellowship.
- They love Christ, never grieve the Spirit, live for eternity.
- Are you a great member? A daily walk with God is key.

They Live Holy Lives and Hate Sin

- Our God is holy: a church is only as holy as its members.
- This is one of our 15 questions; it is crucial to be great.
- Never forget what Achan did and how it cost 36 lives.
- All our church members must be holy above all else.
- Are you a great member? Hate sin like God hates it.

They Crave More of the Holy Spirit

- We cannot be like many Baptists to minimize the Spirit.
- They pray to be filled, seek it, and avoid grieving Him.
- The pastor emphasizes 12 ministries since Paul wrote it.
- They live holy in the Spirit for fellowship and power.
- Are you a great member? Learn Ephesians and beg it.

They Bear Much Fruit of the Spirit

- Great Christians and members abound with Spirit's fruit.
- They know the fruit and bear it all by Christ's strength.
- They abide in Christ the Vine and glory in every fruit.
- They walk in the Spirit rather than just live in the Spirit.
- Are you a great member? Which fruit are you weak in?

They Are Diligent Bible Students

- What is a student? A member that studies the Bible.
- They beg for knowledge and apply themselves to read.
- They listen intently to sound doctrine to defend truth.
- They apply the Bible rightly and strongly to all matters.
- Are you a great member? Separate and intermeddle!

They Love Praying

- Prayer is the most powerful way for any member to help.
- The first 3000 members in Jerusalem prayed (Acts 2:42; 12:12).
- Prayer request tables are available and a member page.
- Every member could attend one prayer meeting a month.
- Are you a great member? Change to be a prayer warrior.

They Are Great Examples to Children

- Without a miracle, children will be as spiritual as parents.
- So compromise, hypocrisy, neglect will be perpetuated.
- The future of the church is by your present child training.
- Think Hannah, Jonadab, Lois and Eunice ... not David, Eli.
- Are you a great member? You daily choose the future.

They Never Change or Vary

- Good character includes consistent, constant faithfulness.
- If you vary from week to week you cause others to worry.
- God, Christ, Spirit, and Bible do not change. Why do you?
- Your actions, words, and moods should be more constant.
- Are you a great member? Purpose to be the same alway.

They Obey *One Another* Duties

- One Another = each member treating each other member.
- Its 32 occurrences cover serve, love, consider, exhort, etc.
- Thus, membership is far different from merely attending.
- In a great church, each member serves each other member.
- Are you a great member? What have you done for whom?

They Grasp Diamond Love

- The Golden Rule is to love others as you desire their love.
- The Platinum Rule is to love others as they desire your love.
- Diamond Love is much higher to make a better Christian.
- Acts of service, money, friendship do not go high enough.
- Are you a great member? Getting ready for Christ is goal!

They Defy Comfort Zones

- A sorry human weakness is giving in to comfort zones.
- This weakness will avoid engaging members or visitors.
- Fearful of public speaking, they avoid most participation.
- They are afraid to pray in front of others, so they avoid it.
- Are you a great member? Real zeal has no comfort zone.

They Love the Church Like David Did

- David was obsessed with congregational worship of Jehovah.
- He made above and beyond efforts many different ways.
- He did not slow down with age but did even more for it.
- The ten passages shared from Psalms show his difference.
- Are you a great member? Show God and us your passion.

They Are Not Myopic

- Myopic = getting distracted and worked up by little things.
- Every church will have little issues to nag the nearsighted.
- How can little things bother any in light of what a church is!
- How can little things bother in light of what Jesus forgave!
- Are you a great member? Flush the hundred pence gladly.

They Do Not Meddle in Other Lives

- Peter blasted busybodies in other men's matters (1 Peter 4:15).
- Paul was also against it, especially widows (II Thes 3:11; I Tim 5:13).
- Remember, a church is Freedom Central, so let others live.
- Meddling easily leads to sinful backbiting and talebearing.
- Are you a great member? Perfect others rather than nose.

They Avoid or Crush Cliques

- The one another duties of a church preclude any cliques.
- Those less desirable in a church were put there by God.
- Church is not for family reunions or hanging with friends.
- Differences will exist, but they should be minimized.
- Are you a great member? Avoid the easy for the hard.

They Love Bible Preaching

- They know preaching is a main component of a church.
- They prepare, focus, and review to learn all they should.
- They encourage the pastor and talk of sermons to others.
- Faith comes by hearing, so they pray and listen eagerly.
- Are you a great member? Choose to embrace each word.

They Invest More in the Uncomely

- They do not avoid the uncomely and engage with friends.
- They know Paul's body rules require more time with weak.
- They remember all souls are precious and a church's parts.
- They assign themselves and their children those to pursue.
- Are you a great member? Identify and support the weak.

They Love and Submit to their Pastor

- They esteem the pastor in love for his work (1 Thess 5:12-13).
- They submit to his rule and follow his faith (Hebrews 13:7,17,24).
- They encourage by financial support and church peace.
- They pray for his wisdom and to rightly divide scripture.
- Are you a great member? How can you help your pastor?

They Are Soul Winners

- After family, there is soul winning in the church (Jas 5:19-20).
- After in the church, there is soul winning outside (Prov 11:30).
- Have you saved any like Aquila and Priscilla to be great?
- They pray ... show ... and tell the truth (Rom 10:1; Mat 5:16; Jn 1:41).
- Are you a great member? Easy: Proverbs, small pill, truth.

They Love Forgiveness and Mercy

- Church members are sinners, so both are greatly needed.
- They know the bigger part of love is forebearing (1 Cor 13:4-7).
- They know it is glorious to pass over transgressions (Pr 19:11).
- They do not like to err, but if they must, it will be for mercy.
- Are you a great member? They easily forgive and forget.

They Have a Servant's Heart

- They will do anything for the church without any fanfare.
- They hate being a taker and would much rather be a giver.
- They look and ask for opportunities to serve without note.
- They know the greatest to the Lord are the lowly servants.
- Are you a great member? Find dirty or secret things to do.

They Keep Right Relationships

- Remember the relationships chart and how many you have.
- Great members take care of each one to make all perfect.
- You can reconcile if you offended ... or confront if they did.
- A people prepared for the Lord? Fathers and sons in unity.
- Are you a great member? Do not let any relationship slip.

They Attend Faithfully

- Forsaking attendance at any service is against apostolic rule.
- Attending is not a great member but using it for the church.
- Paul taught it to consider, provoke, and exhort (Heb 10:23-25).
- A kind courtesy is to tell the pastor's office if you must miss.
- Are you a great member? What is a body with parts gone?

They Are Not Hasty

- Haste is a sin, and our emotions call for it often (Prov 19:2).
- Slow down and do nothing when you feel emotions rise.
- Keeping relationships with sinners requires slowing down.
- Sinful hearts want to rush to judgment, but it is sin (Jas 1:19).
- Are you a great member? Slow down. Stop. Be cautious.

They Protect Reputations

- They do not spread secrets; it is talebearing, backbiting, etc.
- They stop those that say negative things about a member.
- They believe the best about each member, or they hope it.
- Talebearing causes bitter strife; a great church will crush it.
- Are you a great member? Be vigilant, quick to stop gossip.

They Emphasize the Body Members

- RCC members go to church to sit, hear, respond, see a skit.
- Bible Christians know they meet together for the people.
- God chose congregational worship to help us hold faith fast.
- Why would you think of anyone else for friendship outside?
- Are you a great member? Just think! Loving one another!
