What is a Messianic Psalm?

MESSIAH = Christ

Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the <u>Messiah the Prince</u> shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

Daniel 9:25-26

How Do We Know Messiah = Christ?

Because the Holy Spirit by John told us!

He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messias, which is, being interpreted, the Christ.

John 1:41

The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things. John 4:25

What is a Messianic Psalm?

A Psalm about Jesus Christ.

How Many Messianic Psalms?

About 15 to 25 depending on density.

What is Messianic Density?

How much of the Psalm is about Jesus, and how strongly it can be confirmed, especially by quotations in the N.T.

Does Density Vary?

Some Psalms are only about Jesus, and they are quoted many times in the N.T.

Others have sections about Him, or only short mentions, or only indirect reference, without N.T. quotations.

<u>Lists and Tiers Are Not Inspired</u>

The top tier of six are strongly Messianic, and they are a good group to learn first.

The second tier has identifiable content or N.T. quotations to confirm Messianic.

David's Prophecies of Jesus

Most Christians Know Little about Psalms Beyond 23. Yet It Is Quoted Extensively in the N.T. and Is to Be Sung. Jesus Quoted the Psalms More than any Book, Even Isaiah. The N.T. Quotes Psalms over 100 Times (40% of quotes). Hebrews – Jesus Is Better – Quotes (50% from Psalms).

David's Prophecies of Jesus

Jesus Is Son of David (16 in NT), so David wrote much.

David Was a Prophet, so He Wrote of Jesus by Inspiration.

David Was a Great King Himself and Knew His Son Was Better.

One of Seven Ways to Love Christ More is Here in Psalms.

Six: (Hebrews; Gospels; Songs; Sermons; Friends; Pray).

David's Prophecies of Jesus

The Greatest Topic in the Bible to Study is Jesus Christ.

Let's Be Like the Greeks that asked, We Would See Jesus.

If We Are Great In Other Ways But Neglect Christ, We Lose.

For Example, Psalm 22 Is the Most Graphic of the Cross.

Hebrews – Jesus Is Better – Has Six Quotes in Chapter 1!

David's Prophecies of Jesus

Love or Lack of Love of Jesus God's Son Is Rewarded.

Two Women Both Loved Jesus, but Mary Chose the Good.

We Honor or Dishonor God the Father by Treatment of His Son.

The Holy Spirit Testifies of Jesus and Is Grieved by Neglect.

What if We Get More Excited About #47 or S.B. #59?

That all men should honour the Son,
even as they honour the Father.
He that honoureth not the Son honoureth
not the Father which hath sent him.

John 5:23

If any man love not the Lord Jesus Christ, let him be Anathema Maranatha.

I Corinthians 16:22

Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.
